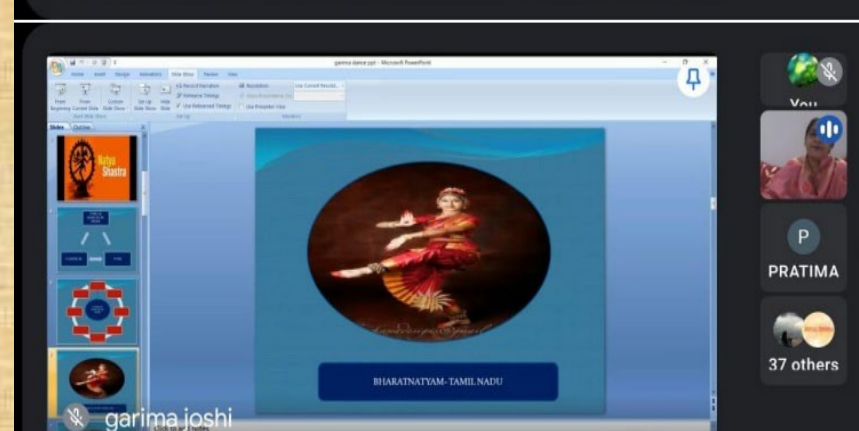

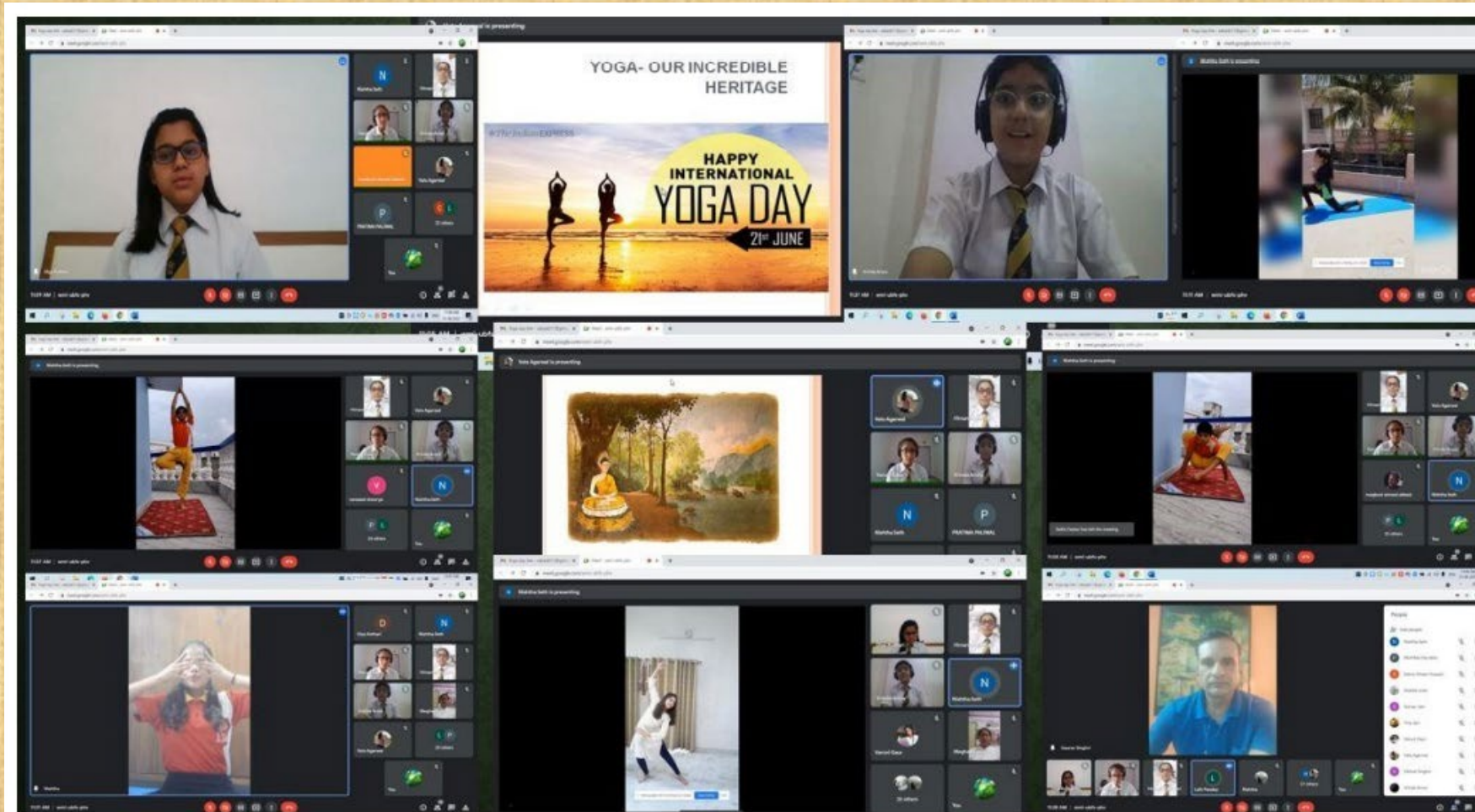

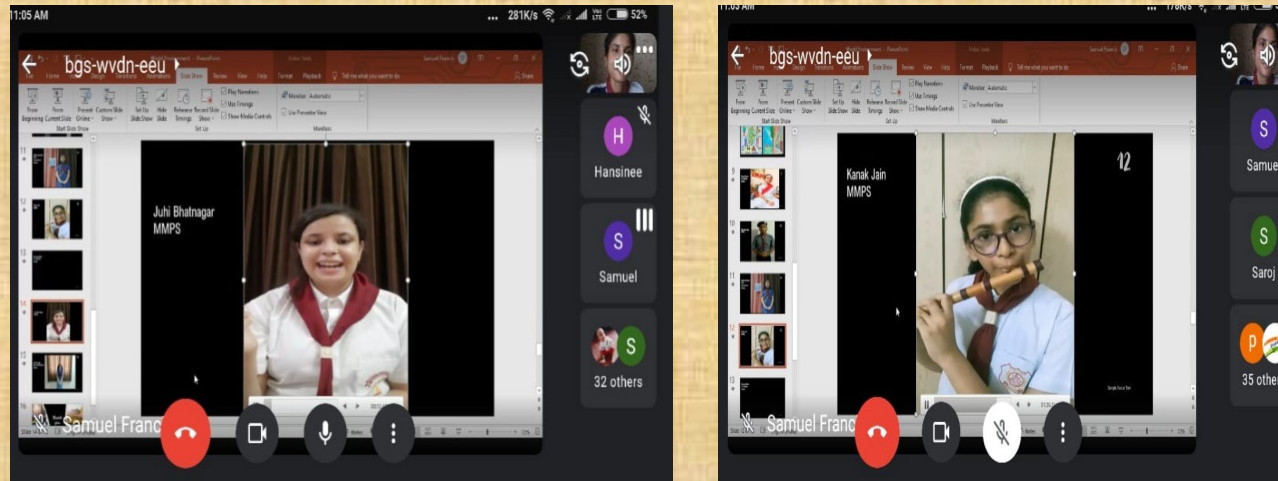

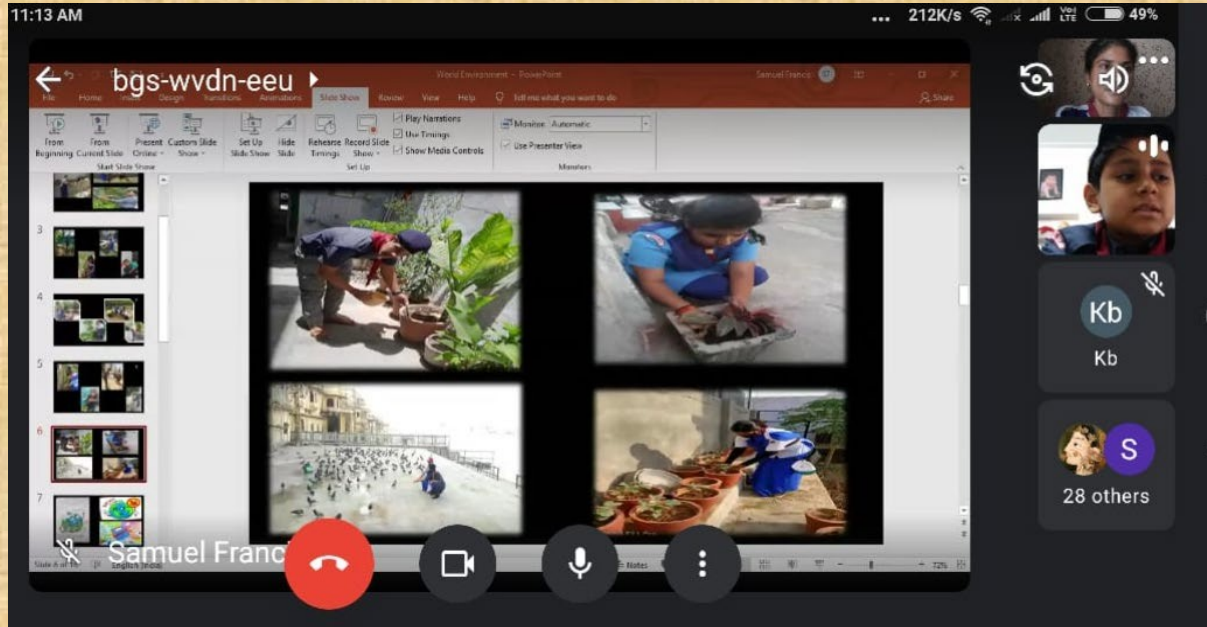

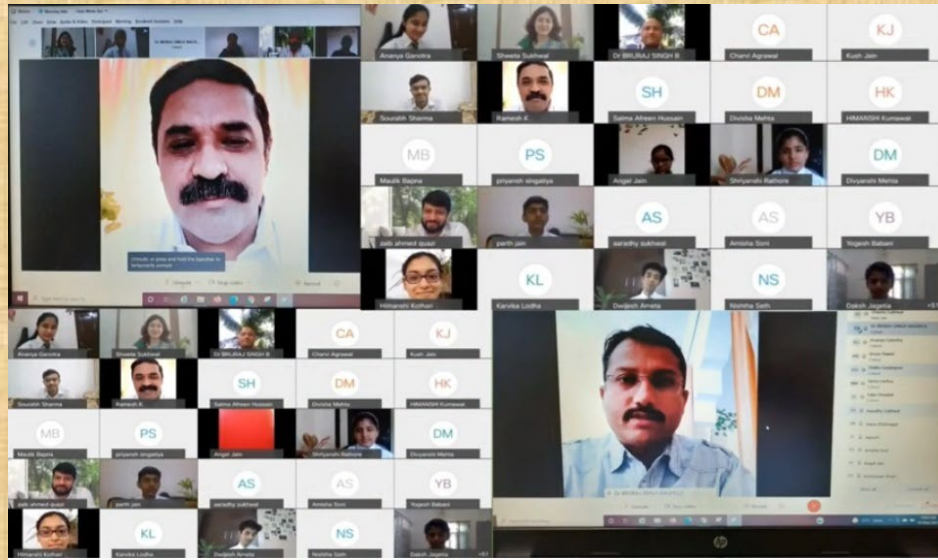
SCHOOL ACTIVITY

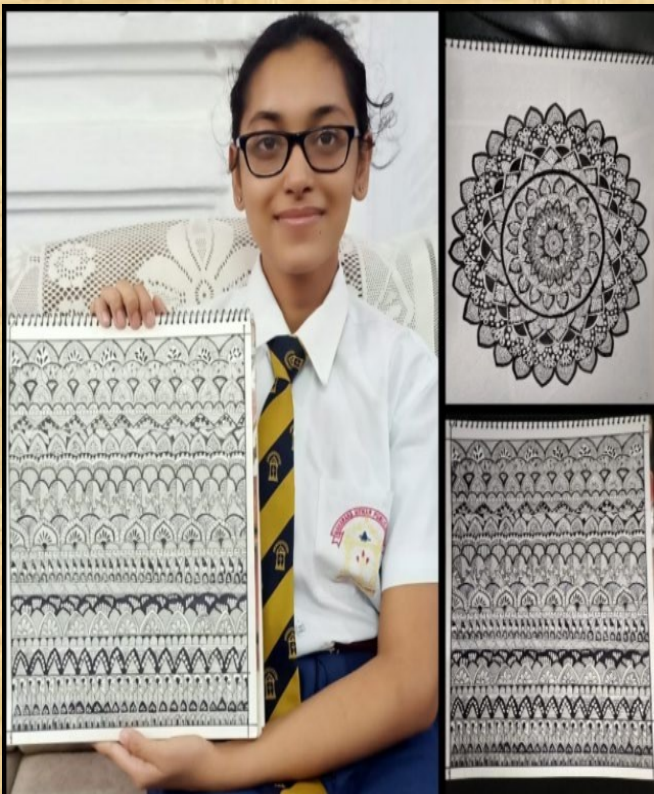
