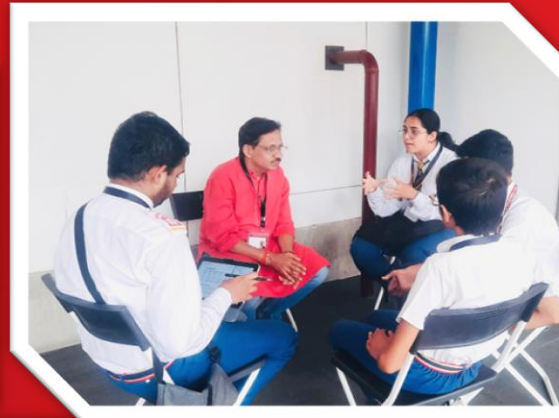

HANDS-ON LEARNING FOR BETTER CLASSROOMS – MMPS STAFF IN ACTION!!

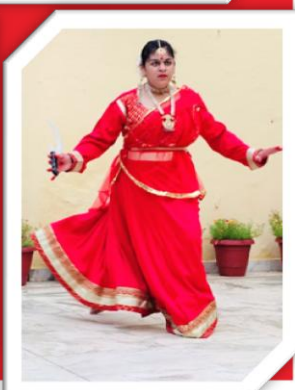
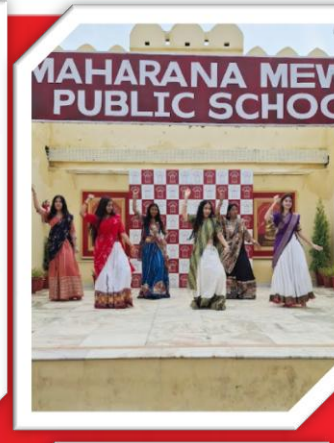

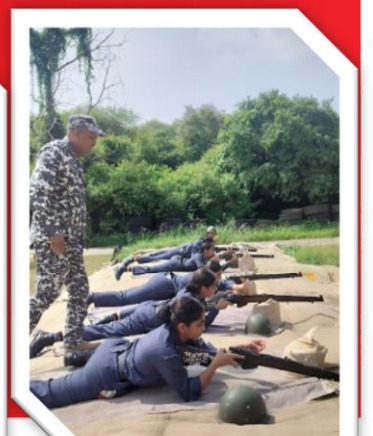
COMMEMORATING COURAGE, PROMOTING PEACE- MMPS AIR WING IN ACTION!

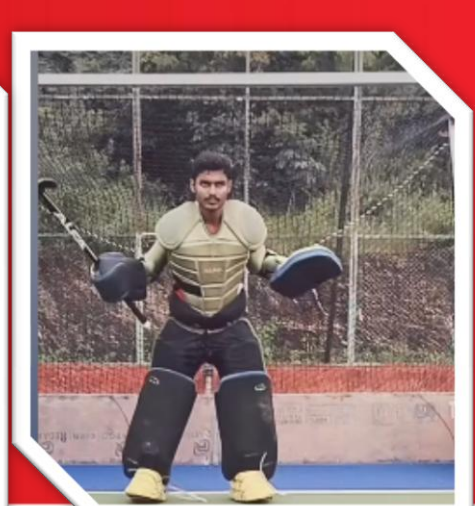
