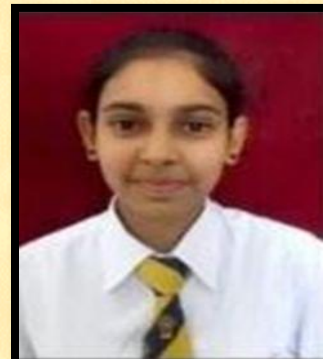

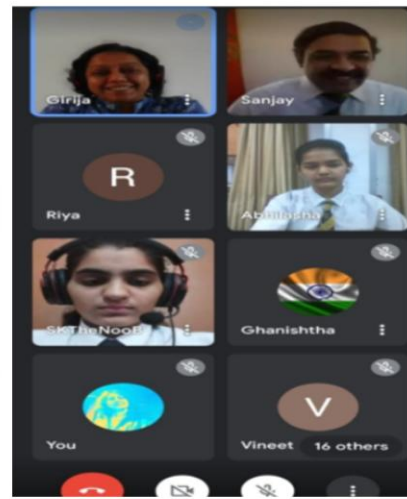

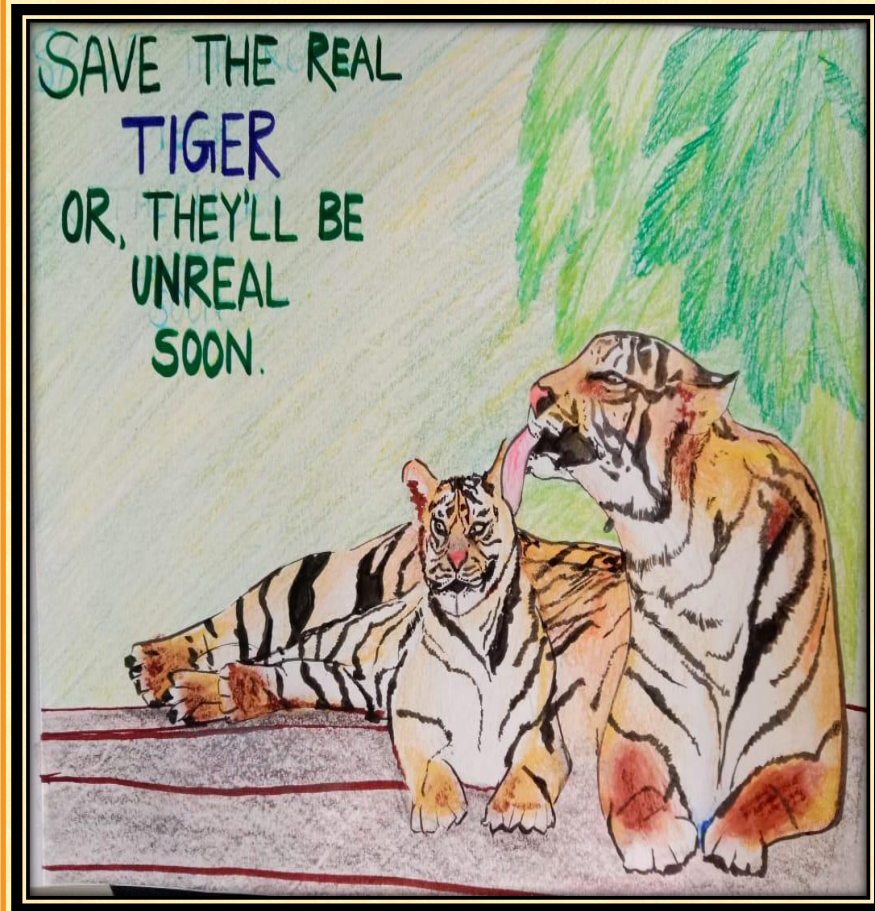

## **‘MMPS TEAM SELECTED FOR ASTEROID SEARCH CAMPAIGN’-**

❖ **Three Teams of MMPS out of 30 Teams from Rajasthan were selected for the DST - Rajasthan Asteroid Search Campaign organised by the Department of Science and Technology, Rajasthan in collaboration with International Astronomical Search Collaboration (IASC) founded by NASA from August 3 – 27, 2021. IASC is a citizen science program which provides high quality astronomical data to citizen scientists around the world. They are able to make original astronomical discoveries and participate in hands-on astronomy. All the participants underwent an online training for analysing the real time telescopic data with Astrometrica Software to search new asteroids under the programme and received the Certificates of Participation. The Team was headed by Dr Rakhee Trivedi (PGT, Physics) and Dr Kusum Soni (TGT, Science). The Members of First Team comprised Rainy Khandelwal, Samyak Mehta, Pratishtha Choudhary, Dev Purbia (X) and the Second Team consisted of Rakshit Bhargava, Sanyam Humad, Gaurang Mishra and Jayant Malvi (X). The Researchers of the Third Team were Surbhi Rathi (XI), Nishant Sharma (XI) and Vedant Maheshwari (XI). The Second and the Third Team also had preliminary discoveries in their name which was featured in the IASC website.**

- It is noteworthy that the Teams comprising Zenab Sabunwala, Shirin Bohra, Hiral Soni, Nitisha Soni, Jaina Choudhary, Drashti Jain, Himank Shrimal and Sarthak Nagar who undertook Preliminary Discoveries of Asteroid Search Campaign in the last session under the able guidance of Dr Rakhee Trivedi have been featured on NASA's Website.
