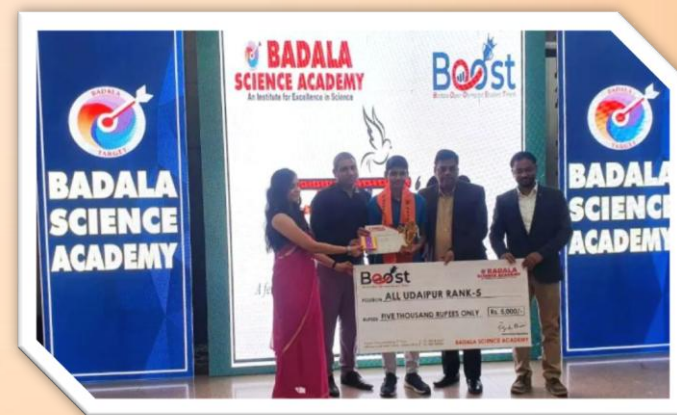

MMPians qualify for the Final Round of India National Spell Bee 2022 Competition at National Level-

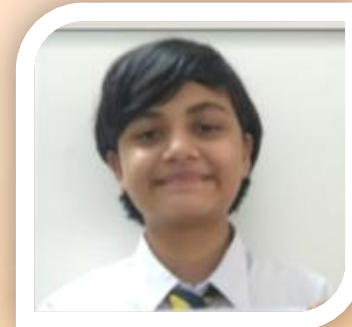

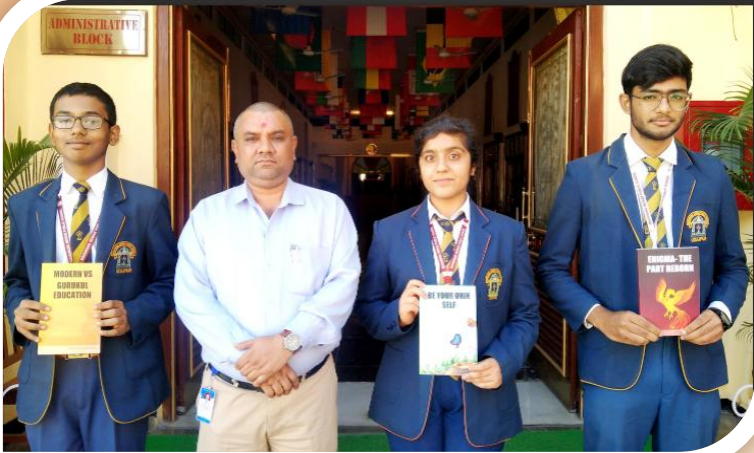
Dhruvika Sharma's Model acknowledges amongst the Top 10 Models in CBSE National Level Science Exhibition

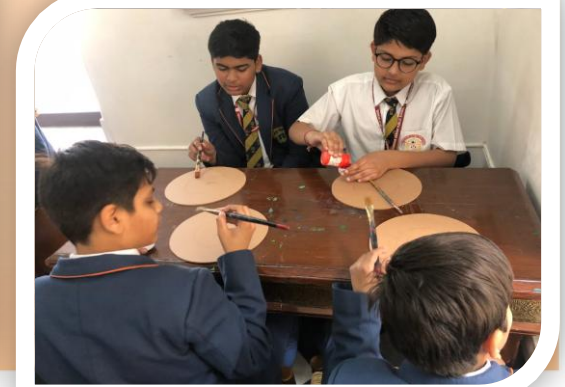

Happy National Youth Day!

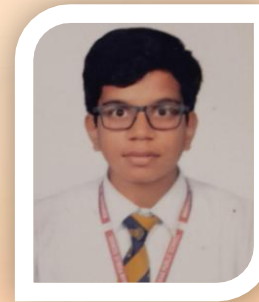

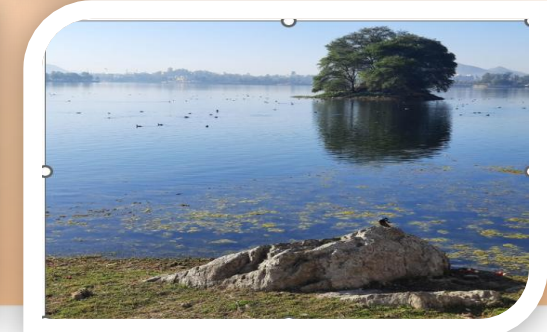
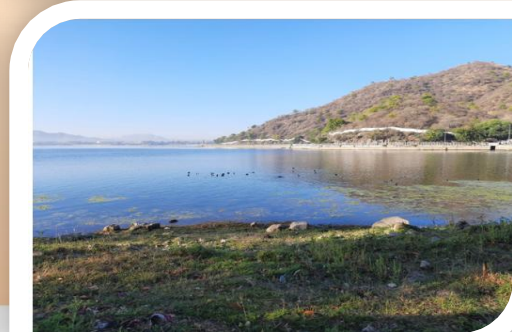
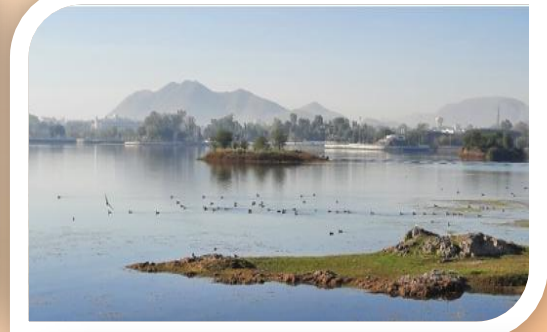
‘Creativity is piercing the mundane to find the marvelous’-
