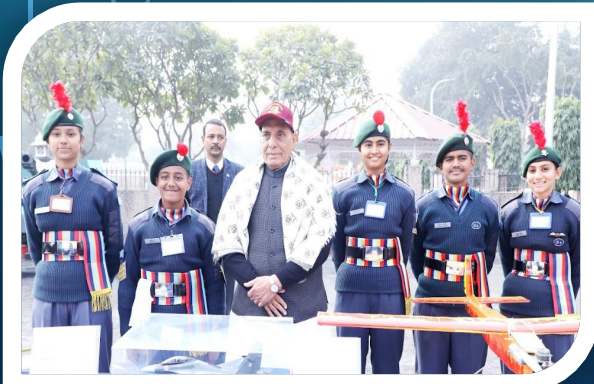


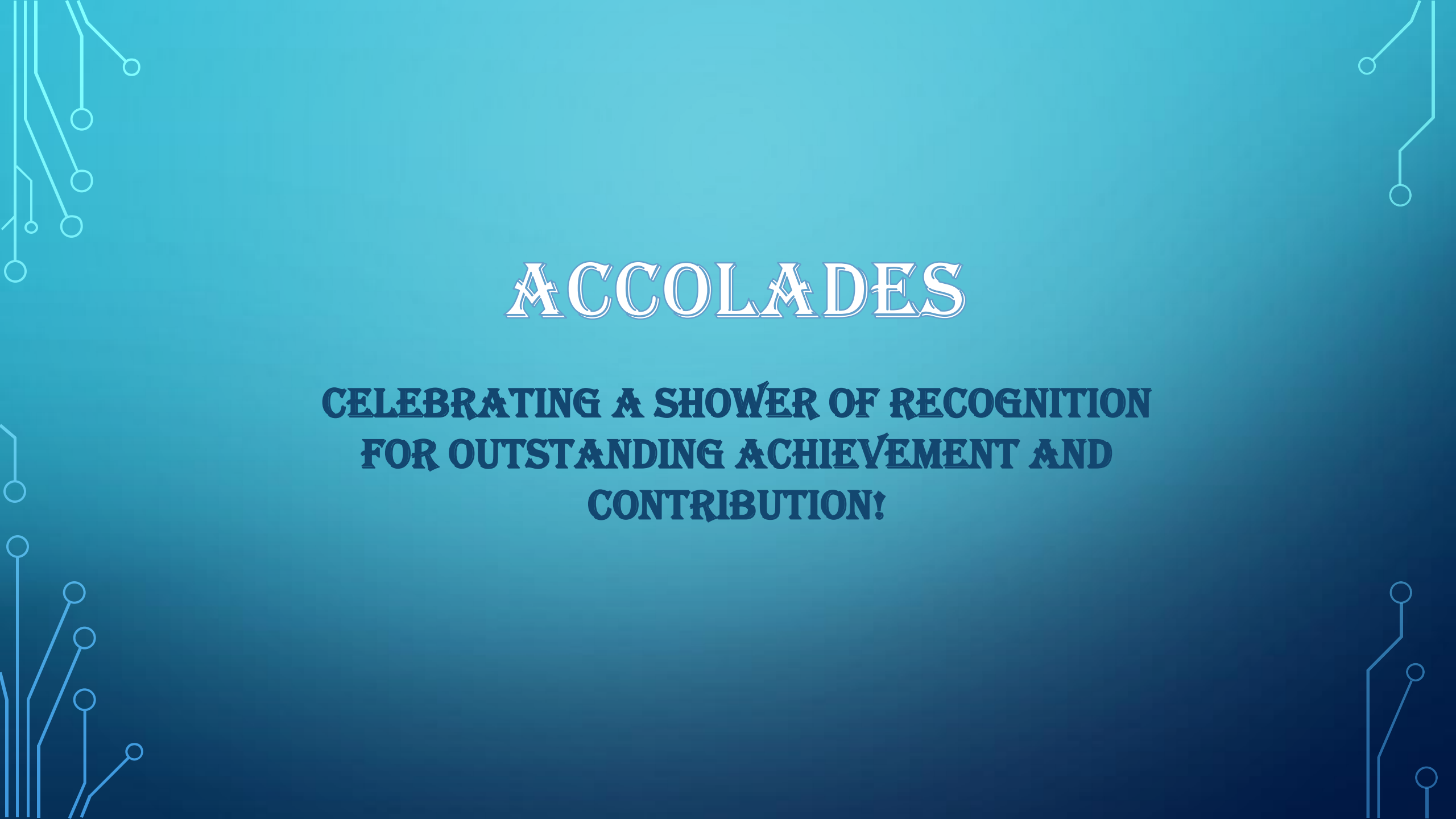

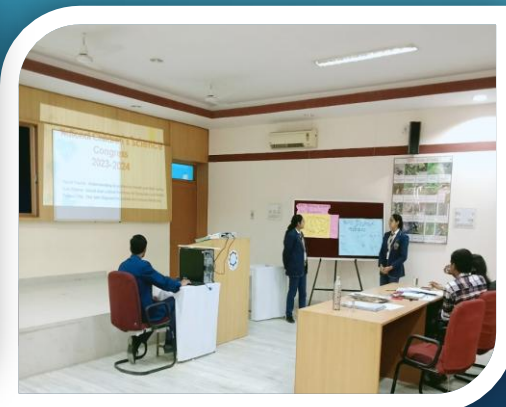
**STELLAR LEARNING:

EXCELLENCE RECOGNIZED: MMPS STUDENTS SHOWCASE THEIR TALENTS ON THE NATIONAL STAGE!

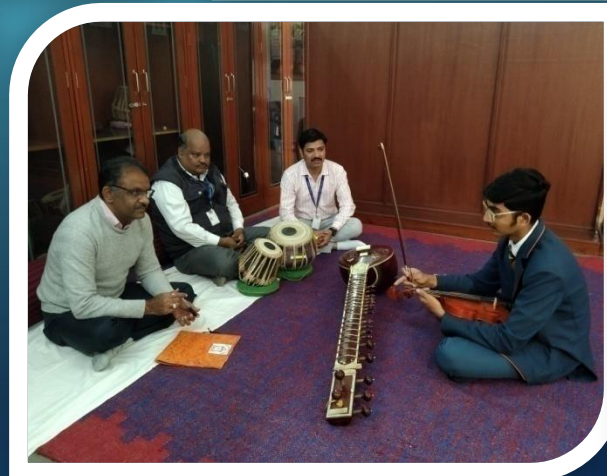
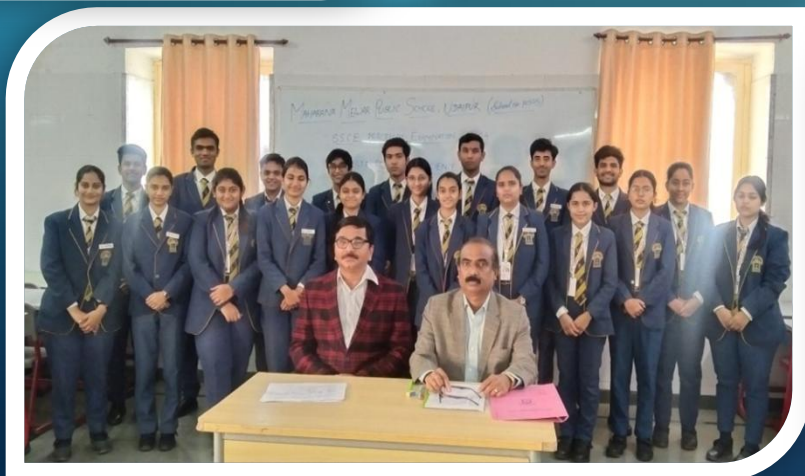

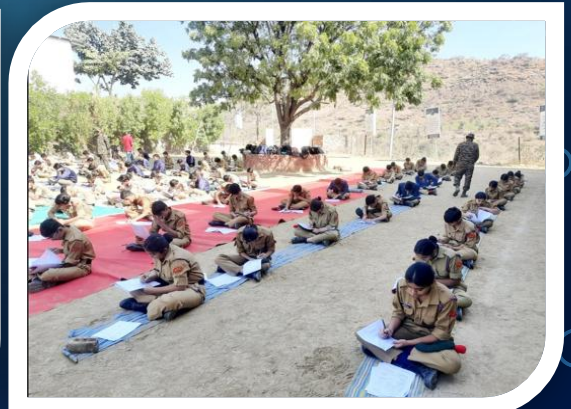
BUILDING TOMORROW'S LEADERS: NCC CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION AT CPS, UDAIPUR!

NCC-A CERTIFICATE EXAM: ABHINAV SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL TAKES THE LEAD!

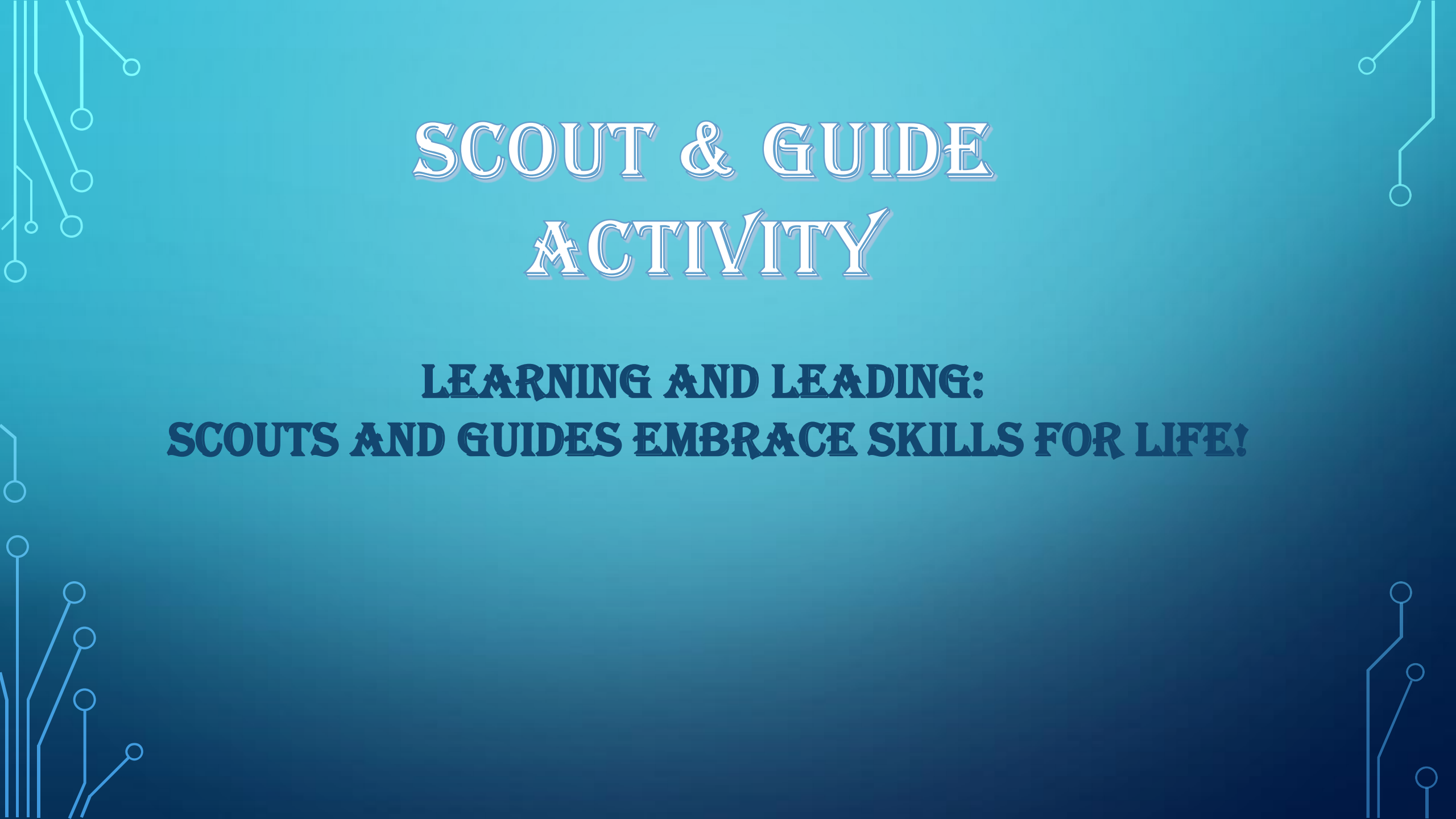

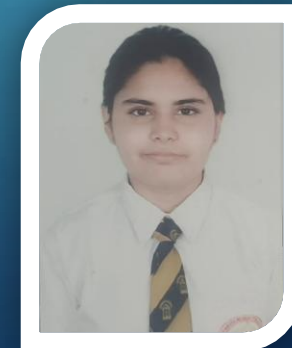

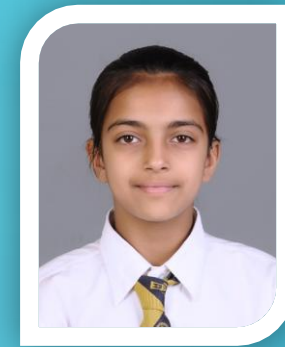
