MMPS ADDS ANOTHER FEATHER TO ITS CAP BY NATIONAL LEVEL RECOGNITION AT THE 31ST NATIONAL CHILDREN'S SCIENCE CONGRESS 2025!

Maharana Mewar Public School excelled at the 31st National Children's Science Congress in Bhopal from January 3-6, 2025. As the only Udaipur School representing Rajasthan, MMPS competed among 700 projects from India and the Gulf, showcasing innovative ideas on the Theme 'Understanding Ecosystems for Health and Well-being'.

Two Teams showcased outstanding projects at the 31st National Children's Science Congress. Ajab Anis Hussain and Fatima Kankroliwala (XII) researched the 'safe disposal of unused medicines', while Druhi Sarupria and Lakshi Mehta (X) focused on the 'organic waste management'. Mentored by Dr Madhu Bala Purohit (PGT, Biology), both teams received high appreciation and were honored with the prestigious Child Scientist Award and Certificates of Merit. Their achievements reaffirm school's commitment to innovation and address critical environmental and societal challenges.



ASTEROID DISCOVERY EARNS RECOGNITION FOR BUDDING SCIENTISTS!

A skilled Team comprising Devya Soni (Team Leader), Hiten Agarwal, Druhi Sarupria, Lavi Mehta and Lakshi Mehta (X) exhibited exceptional scientific prowess in the CB Devgun Memorial Asteroid Search Campaign, organized by the International Astronomical Search Collaboration (IASC) in the 2023-24 academic session. Under the mentorship of Dr Kusum Lata Soni (TGT, Science), they meticulously analyzed astronomical data, leading to the identification of an asteroid. Their asteroid discovery was recorded as a provisional discovery in January 2025 and has now received the official designation: 2023 VS23. This discovery highlights their dedication to astronomy and contributes to the growing field of citizen science.

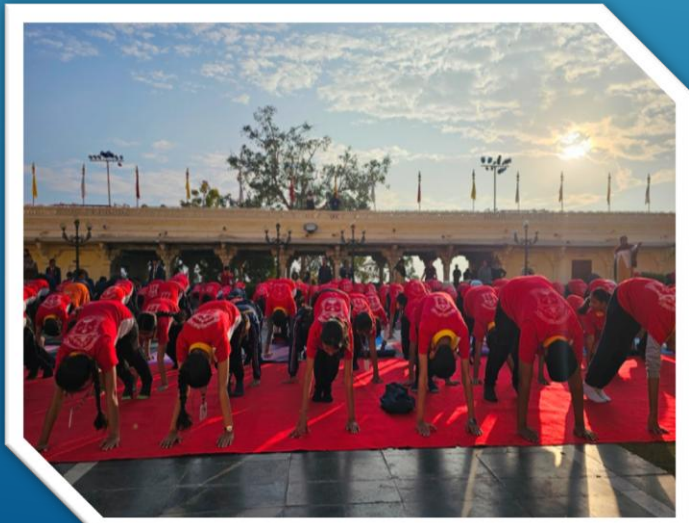

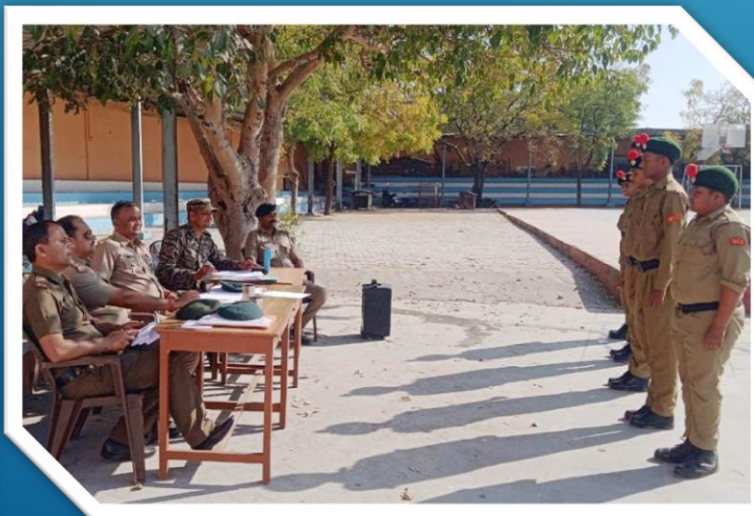
