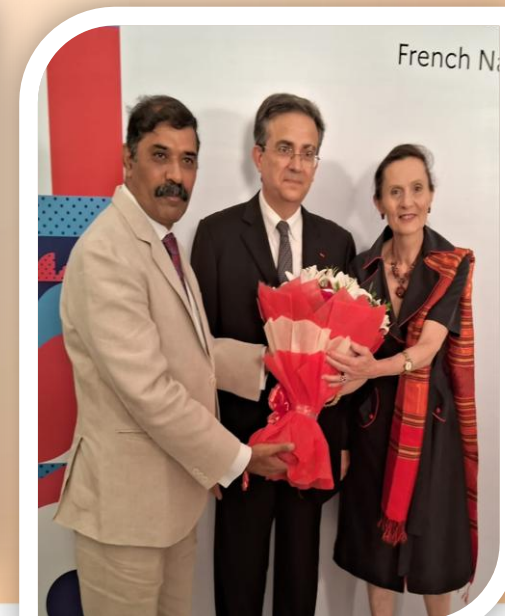

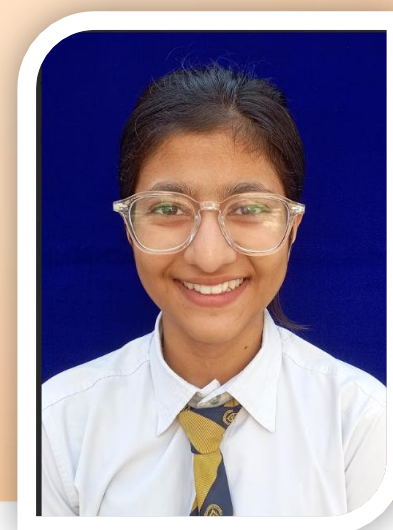

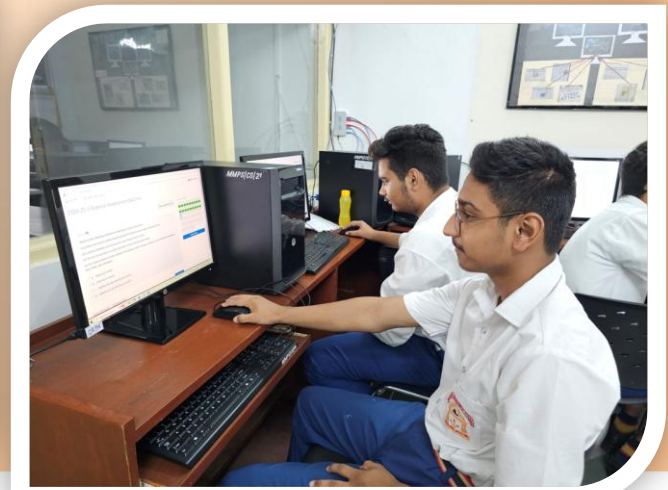
MMPLANS SHINE WITH COMMENDABLE SCORES IN PRARAMBHIK VOCAL EXAMINATION!

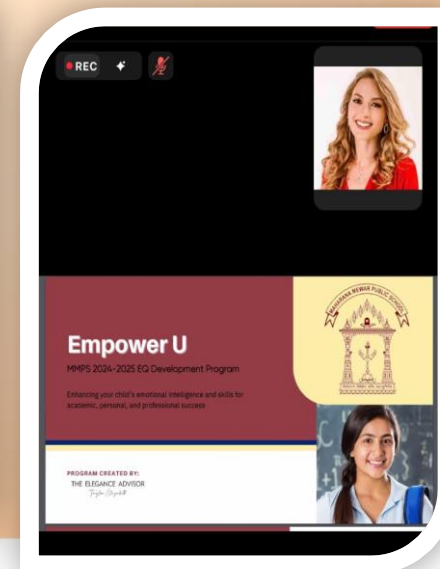
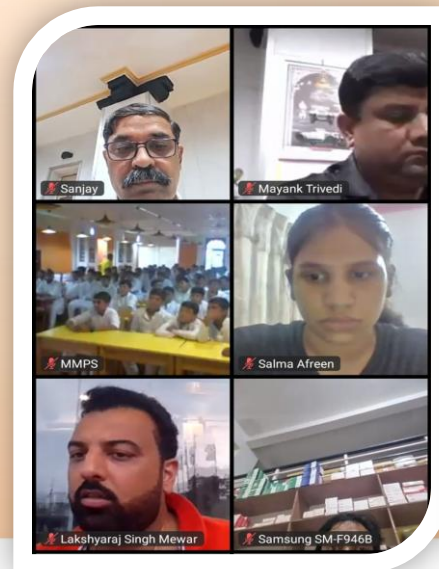
RIYA VAISHNAV WINS TOP SPOT IN DCF WILDLIFE PAINTING CONTEST!

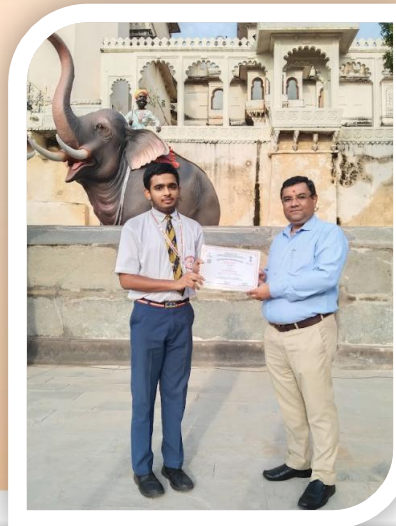
FIRST ROUND OF HCL JIGSAW OLYMPIAD SEES PARTICIPATION FROM 18 STUDENTS!

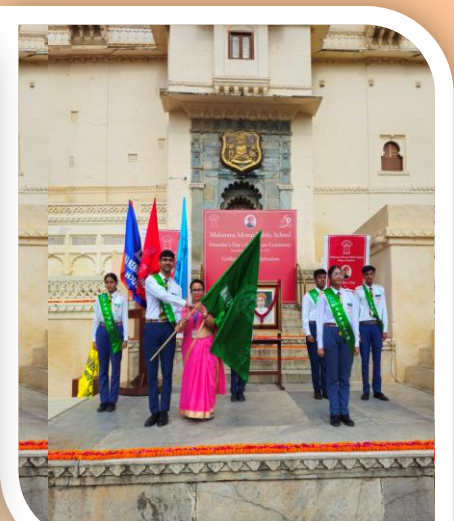

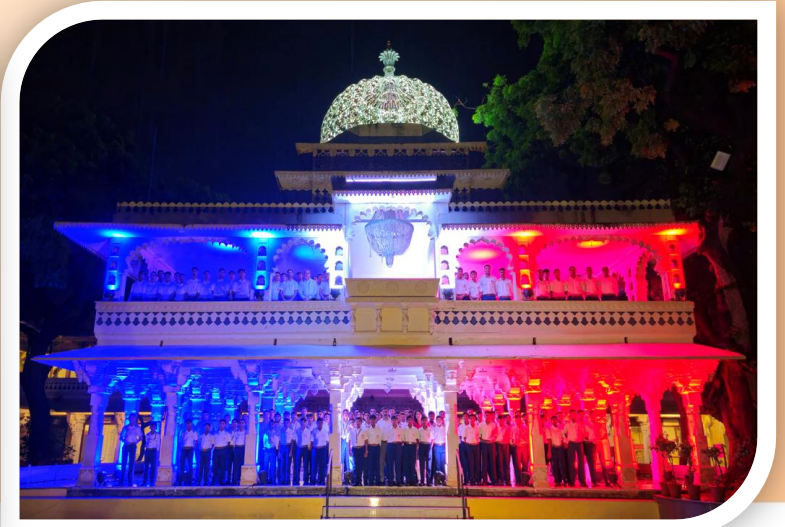






BASTILLE DAY EXTRAVAGANZA: CELEBRATING LIBERTY, CULTURE, AND ART!

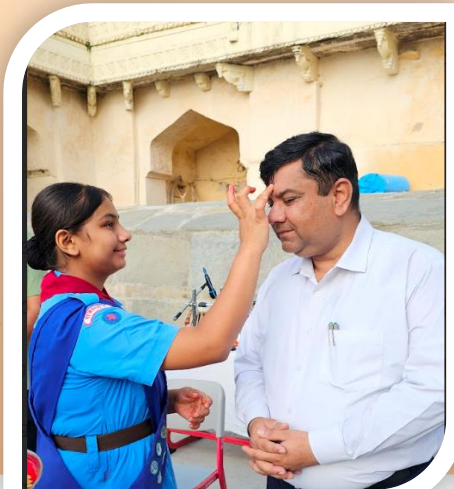
RHYTHM AND MELODIES: INTER-HOUSE INSTRUMENTAL CHALLENGE CONCLUDES!

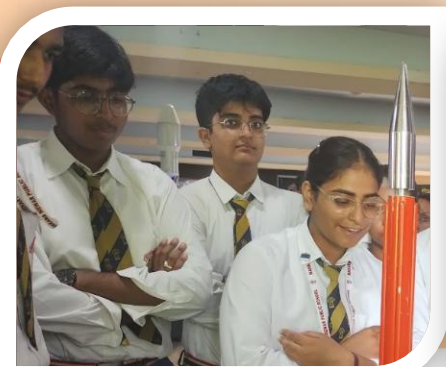

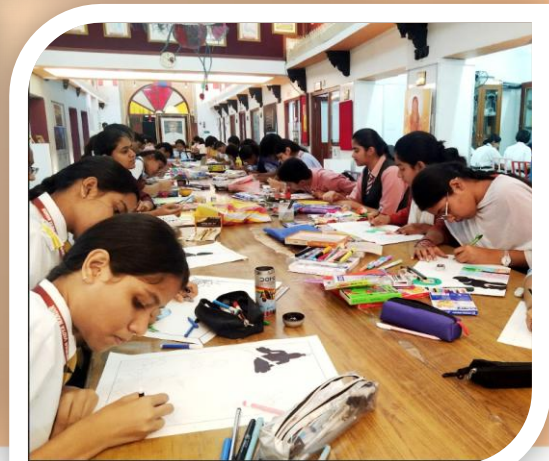


**CELEBRATING SANSKRIT WEEK:

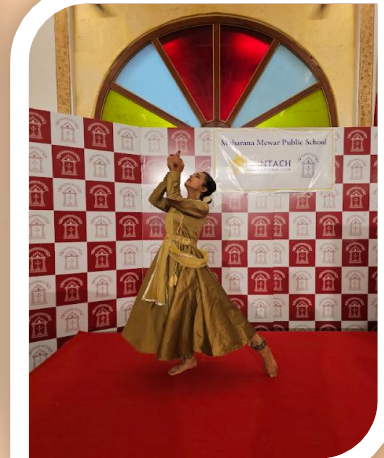

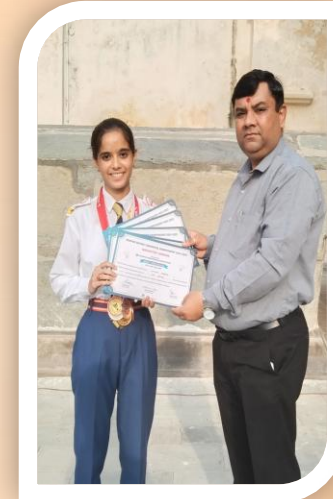
