CELEBRATING EARTH DAY 2024: A UNITED EFFORT AGAINST PLASTIC POLLUTION AT MMPS!

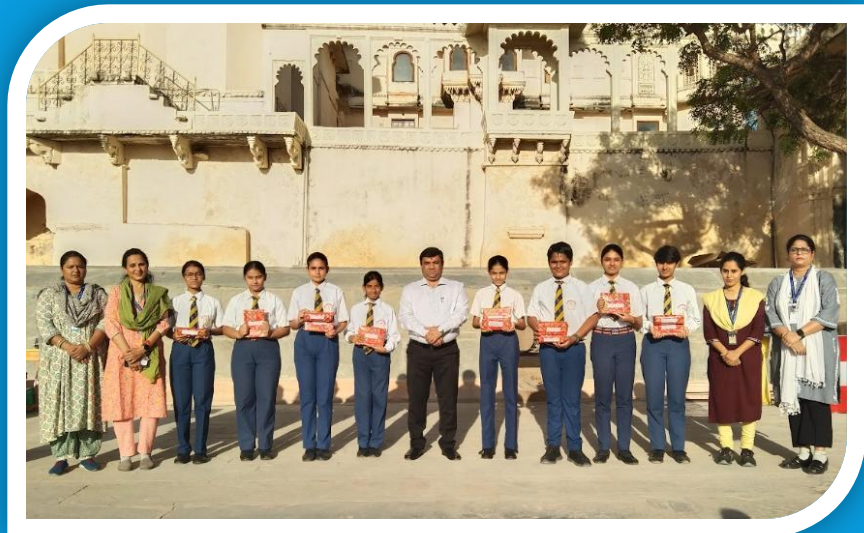
