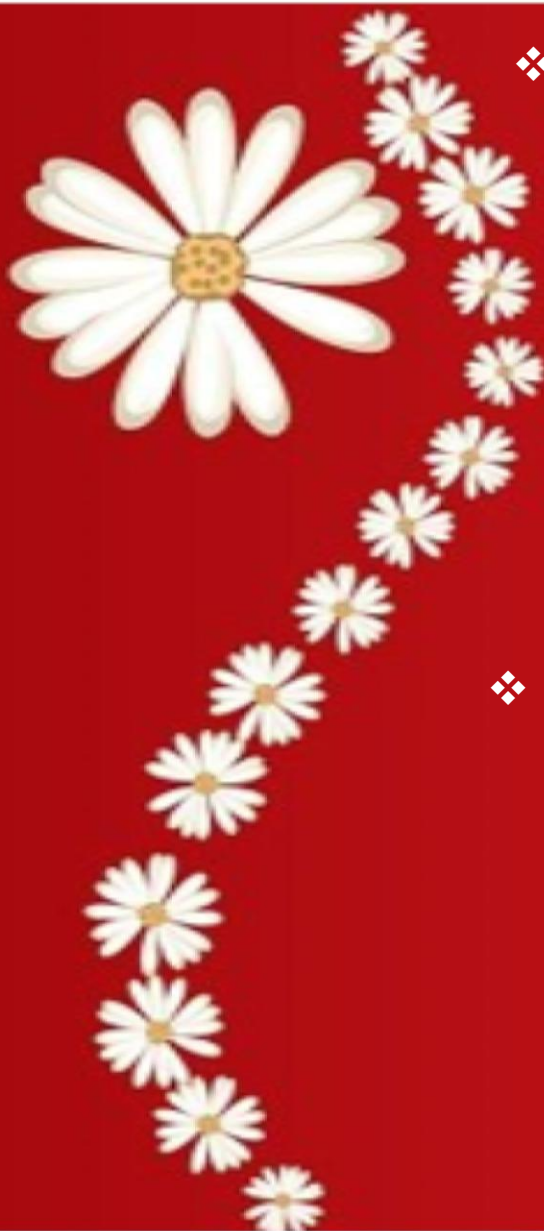
SPORTS ACTIVITY
