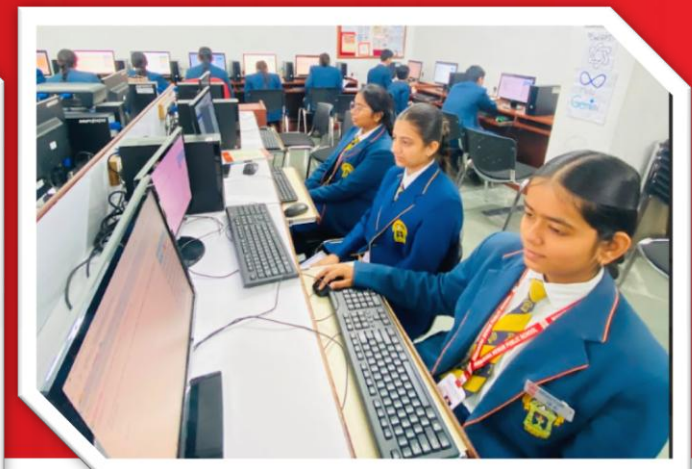
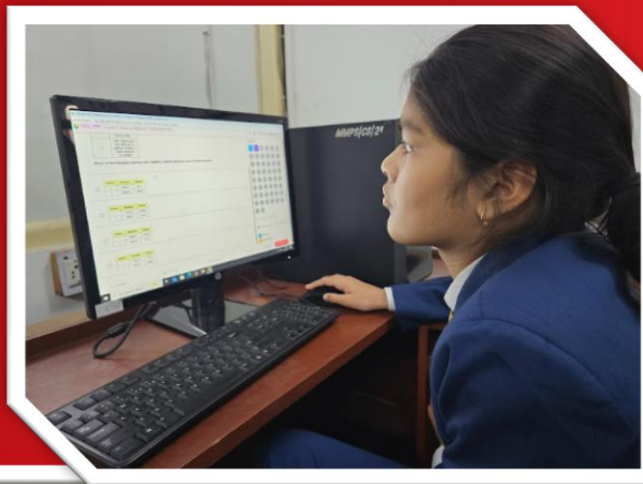




COMPETENCY-BASED LEARNING TAKES SHAPE WITH SAFAL!

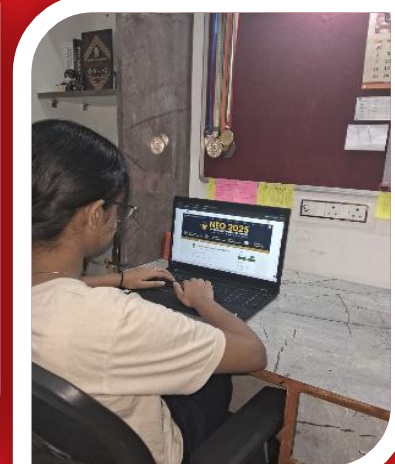

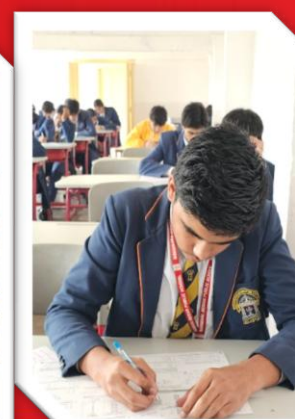
ANALYTICAL MINDS IN ACTION AT THE NATIONAL ECONOMICS OLYMPIAD!

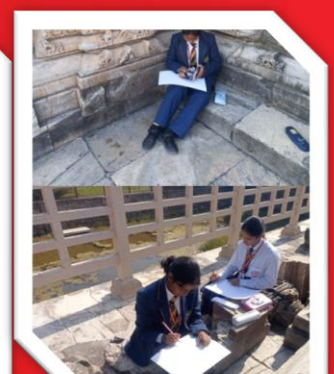
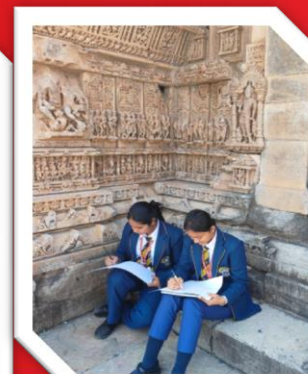
MMPS OBSERVES WORLD DAY OF REMEMBRANCE WITH A STRONG MESSAGE ON ROAD SAFETY!

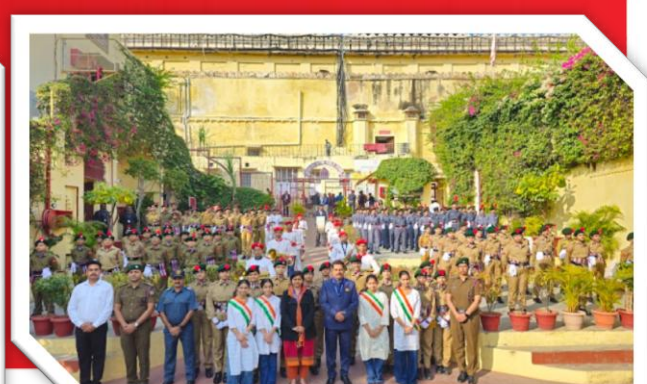
MMPS NCC CADETS SHOWCASING SKILLS DURING COMBINED ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP-XVII!
