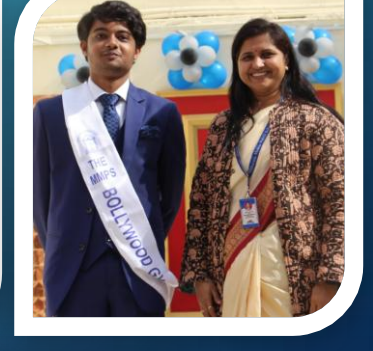
LITERARY EXPLORATION: STUDENTS DELVE INTO THE WORLD OF BOOKS, PUSTAK SADAN!

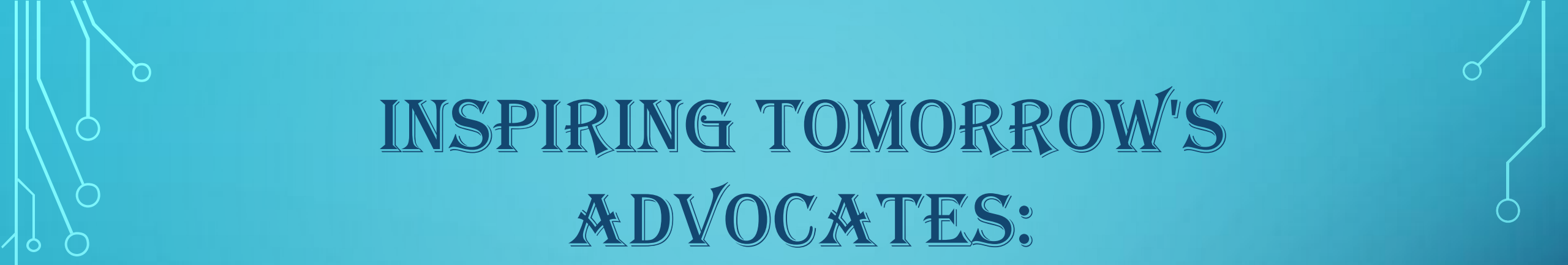

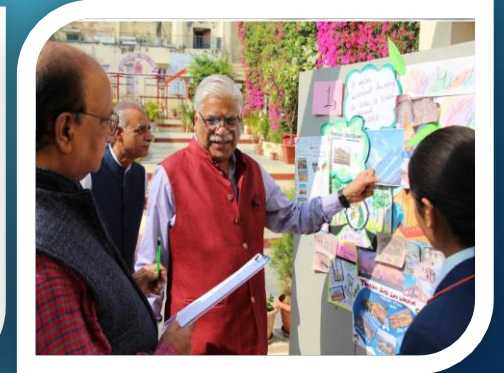

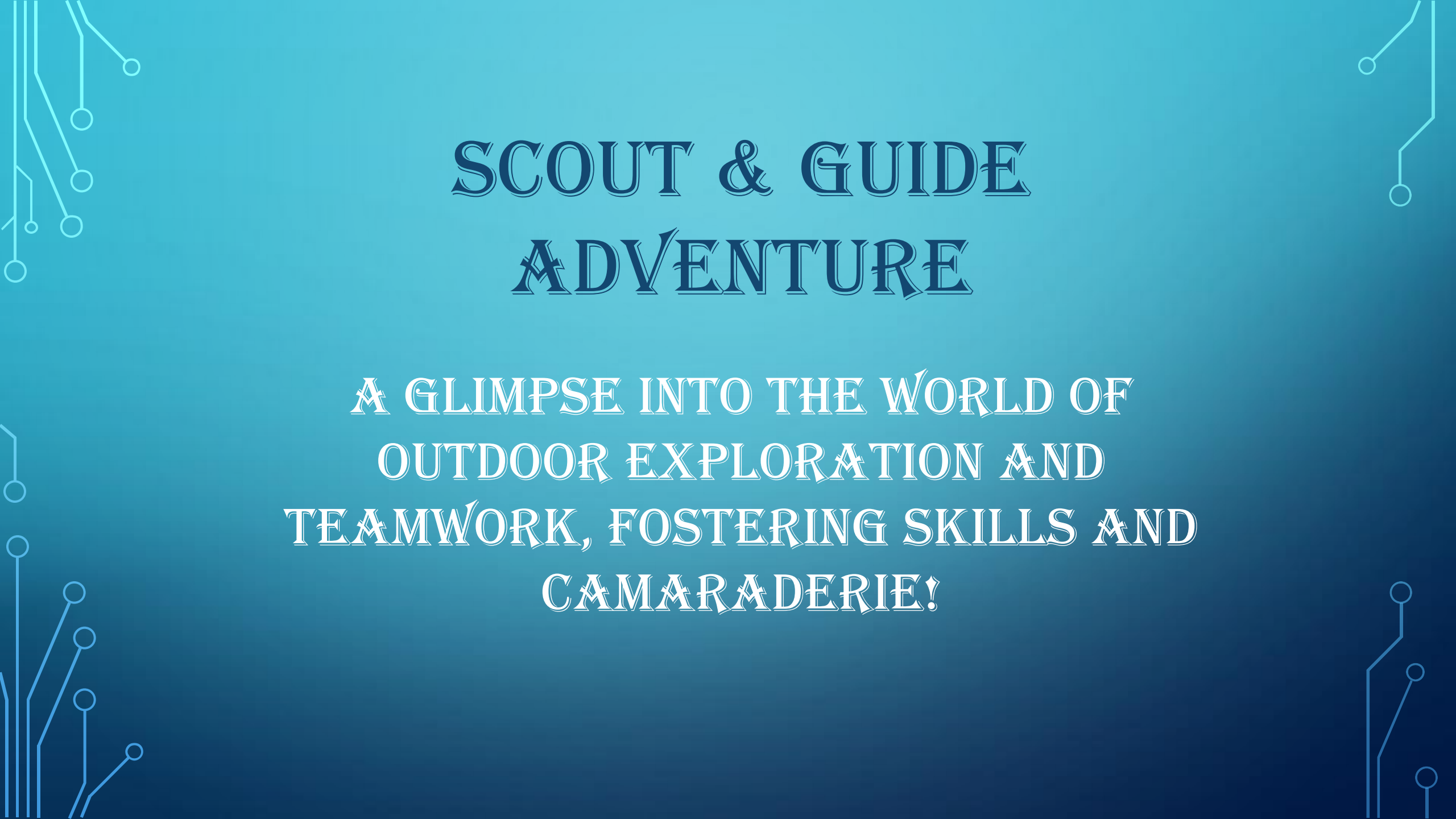
