VERBALIA 2025: INTER-SCHOOL LITERARY FEST AT MAHARANA MEWAR PUBLIC SCHOOL!

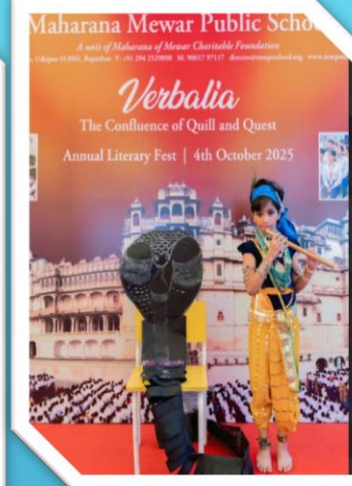
