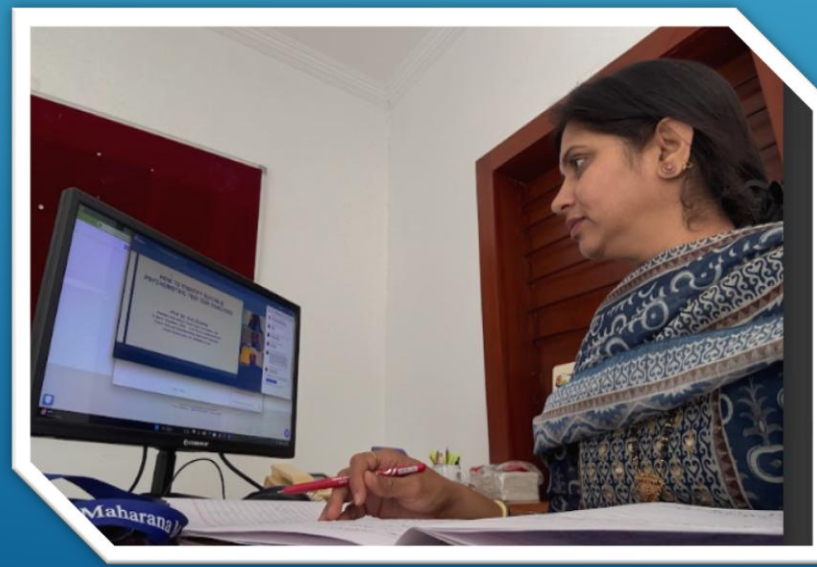

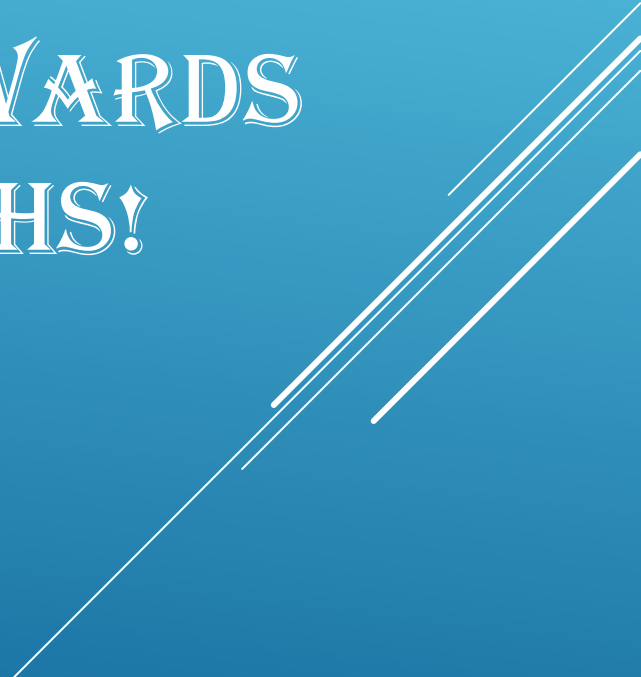
VANSH TALESARA BAGS WEST ZONE RANK I AND WINS AN APPLE IPAD!

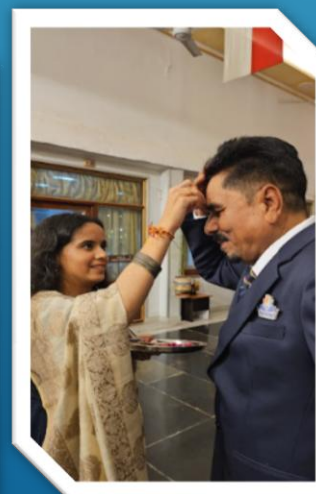

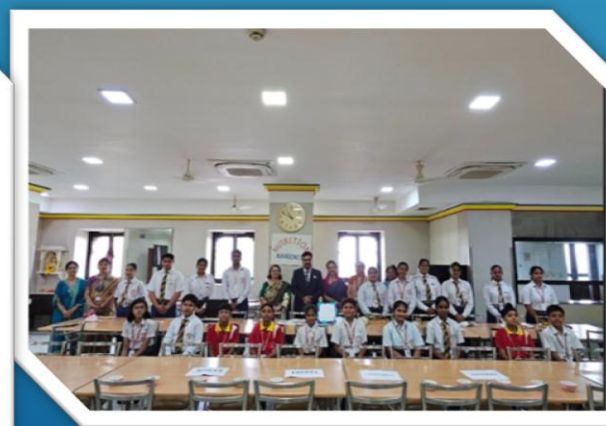
LITERACY TODAY MEANS THRIVING IN A DIGITAL WORLD!

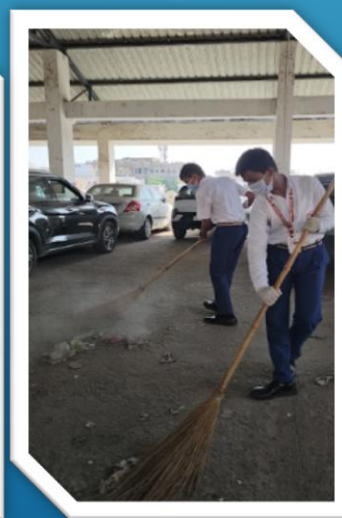
MMPS HOSTS 'GURU VANDANA-STUDENT FELICITATION' TO HONOUR VALUES, CULTURE AND GRATITUDE!

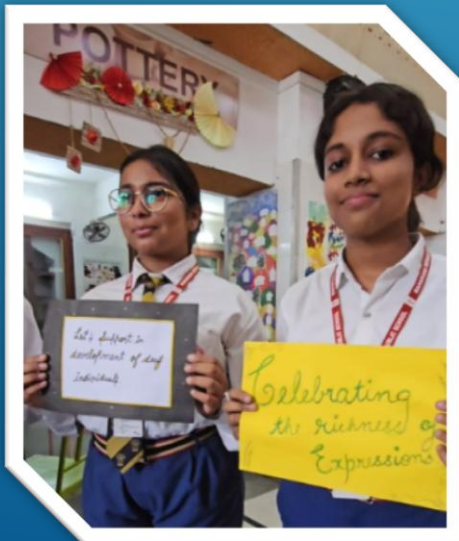
CELEBRATING WORLD OZONE DAY WITH PURPOSE AND AWARENESS!

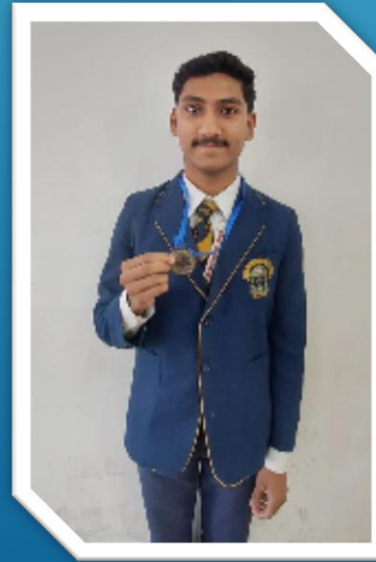

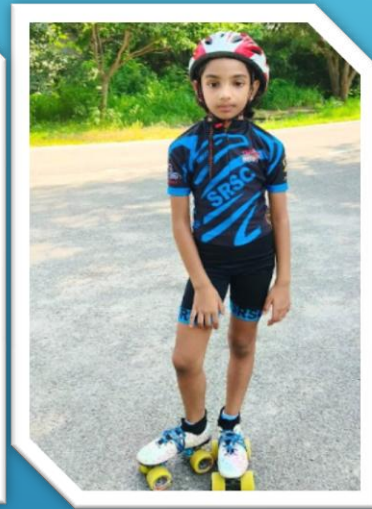
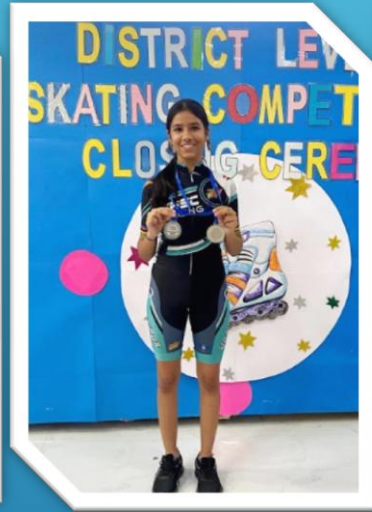
