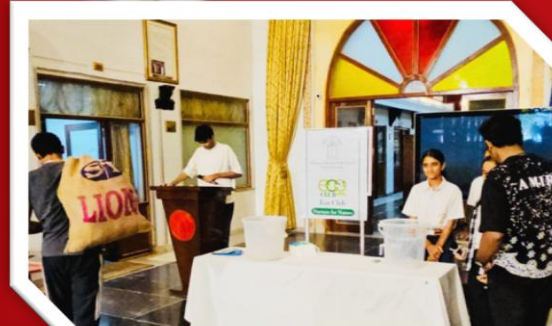
**HONOURING NATIONAL HEROES:

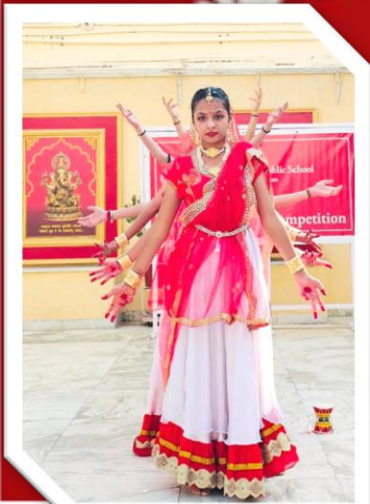
MMPS INAUGURATES SPIC MACAY CLUB TO PROMOTE INDIAN ART AND MUSIC!

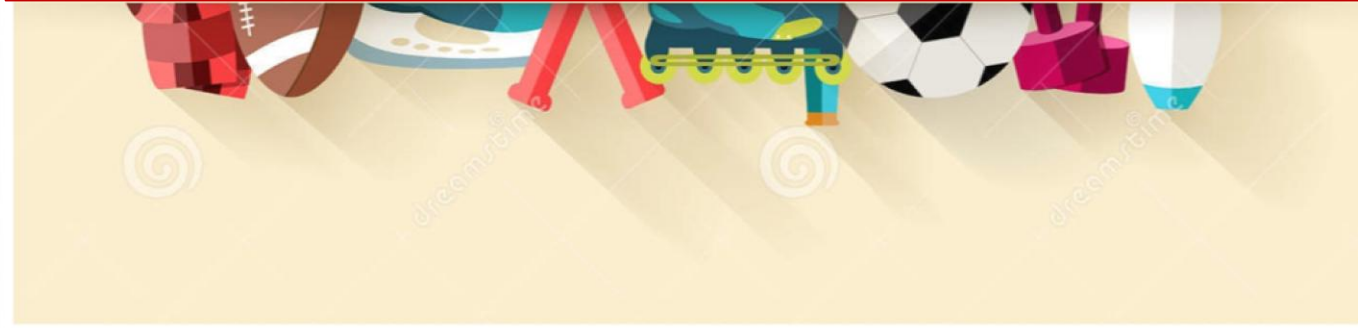
