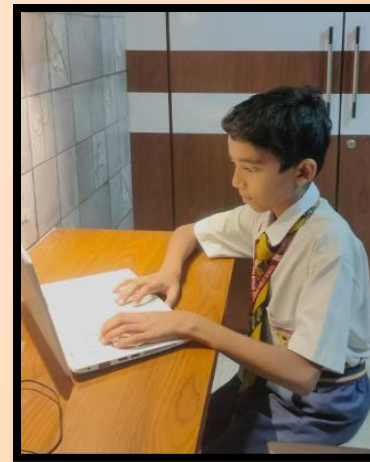

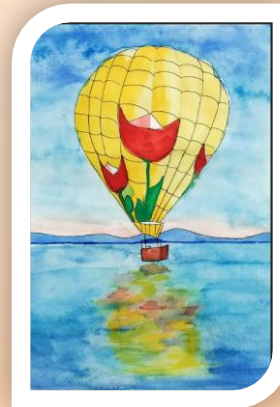

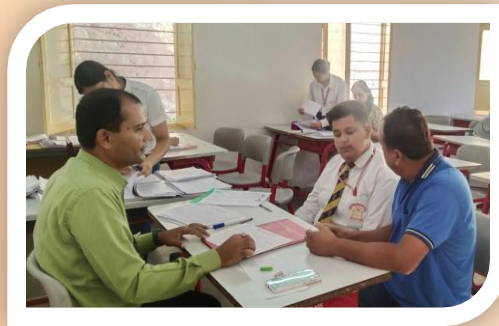

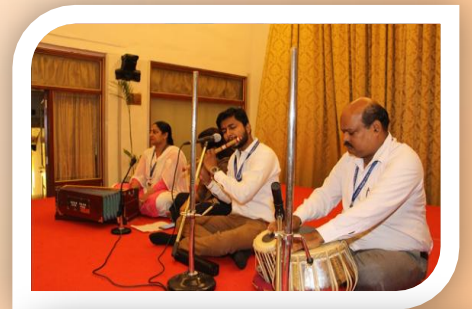
MMPIans witness Inaugural Session of Launch of 5G at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi by Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi

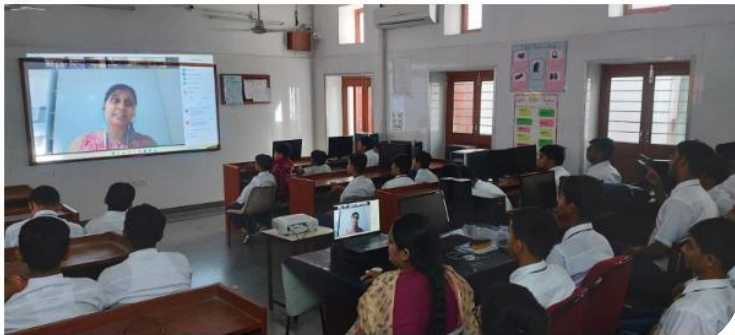

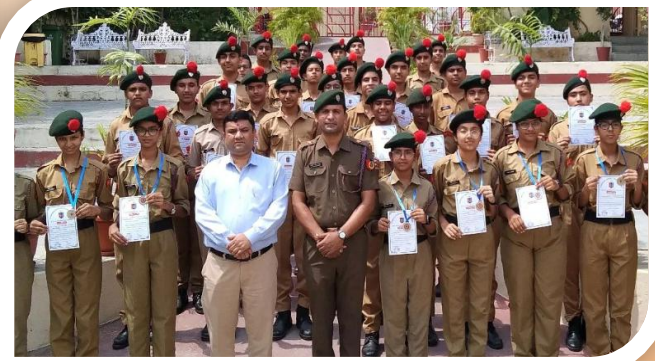


NCC Cadets of 2 Raj Remount & Veterinary Regiment NCC Navania, Udaipur perform exceptionally well in Combined Annual Training Camp

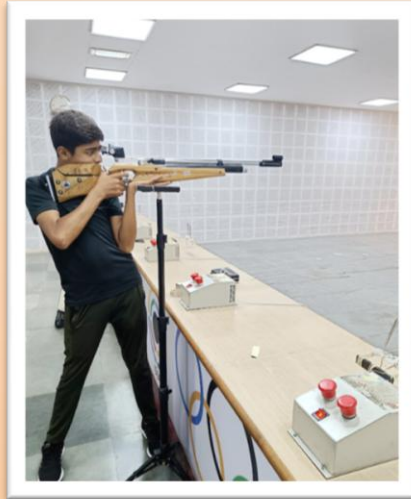
