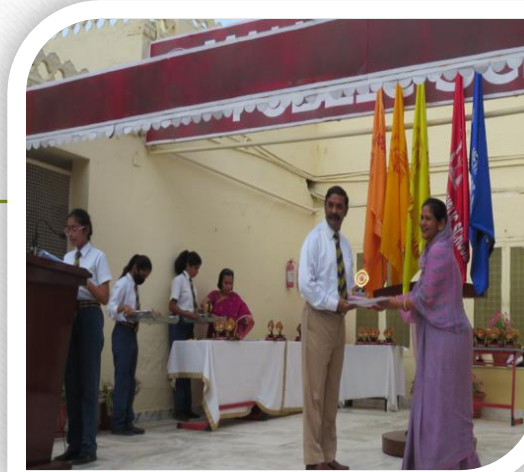
Students and Teachers witness the Fifth Edition of Pariksha Pe Charcha 2022: PM Narendra Modi's Interaction with Students

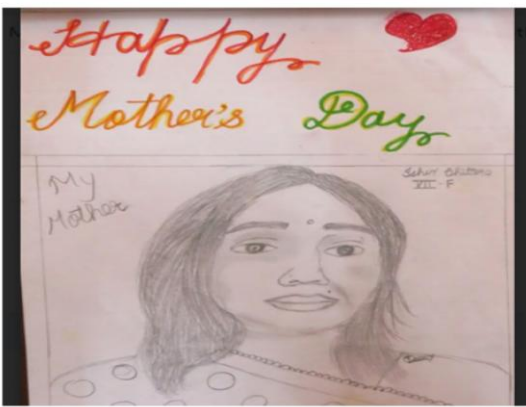

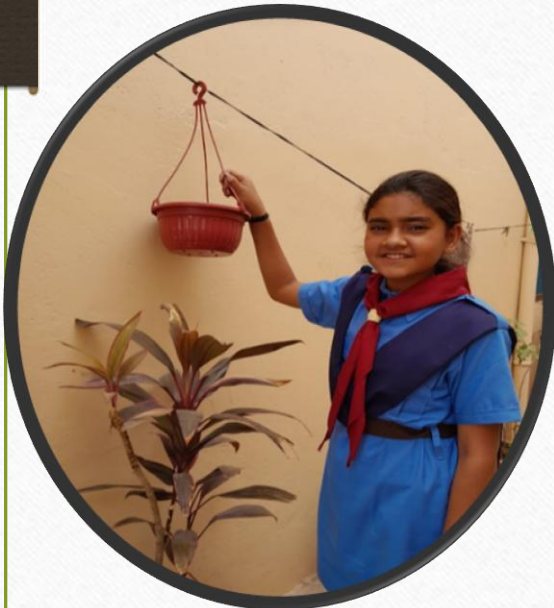
Guides of MMPS participate in Campaign Run against Child Marriage

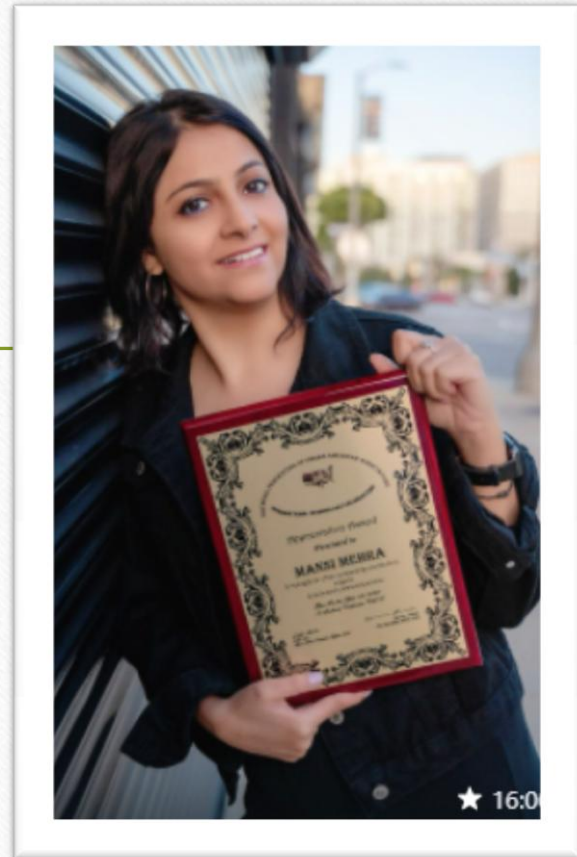

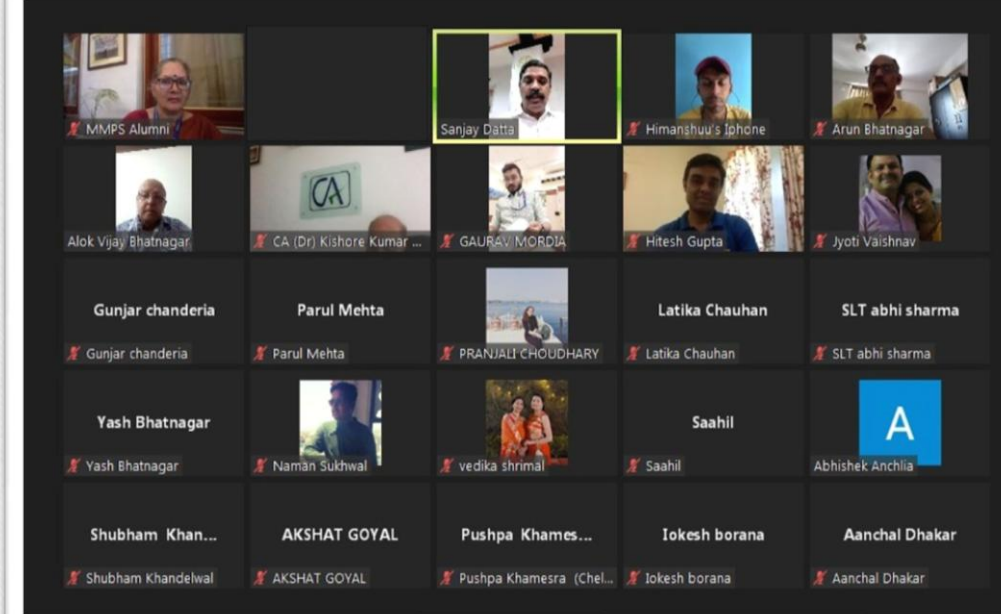
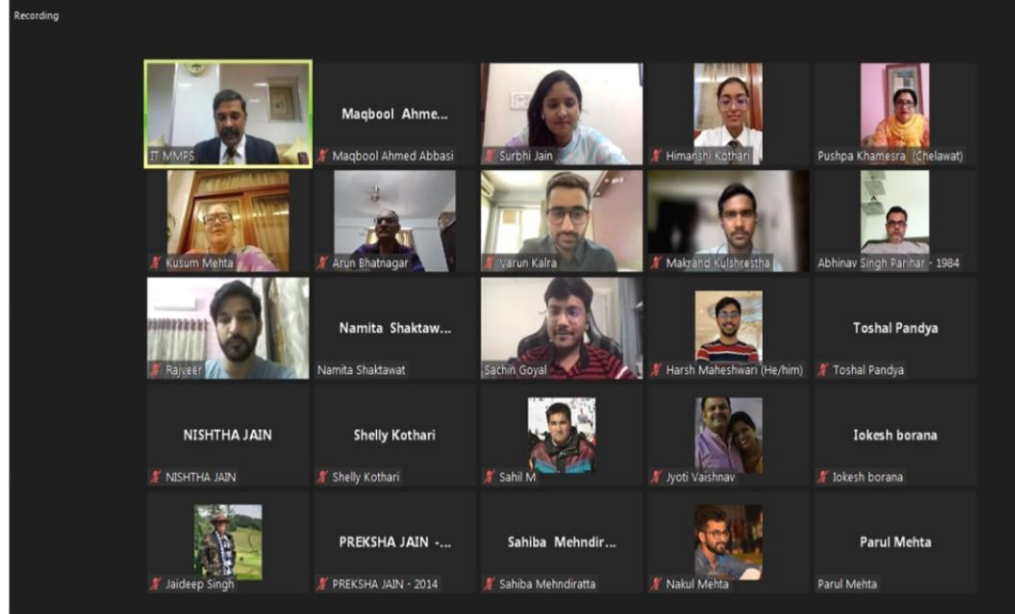
