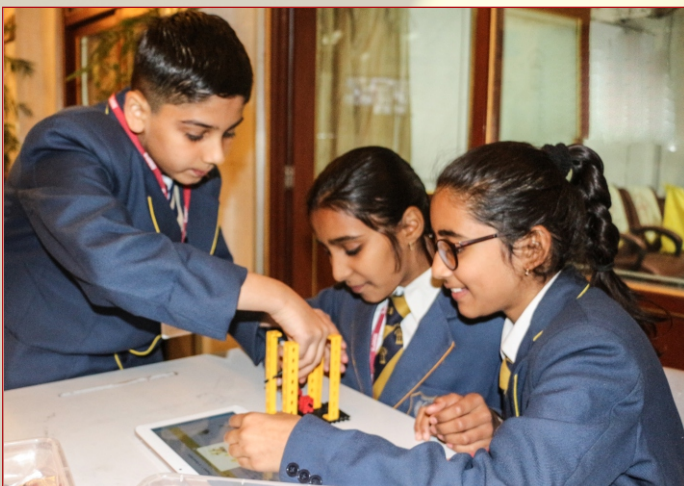

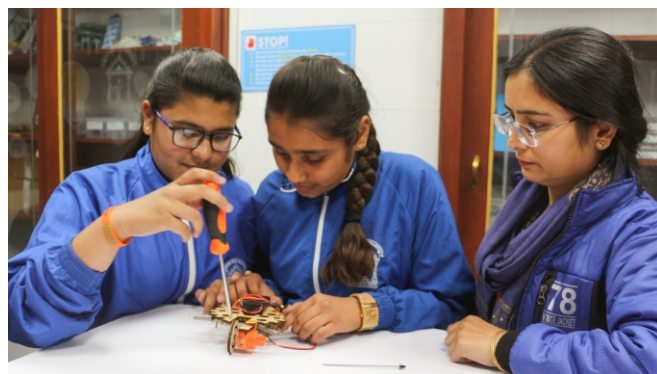
DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE ACTIVITY
