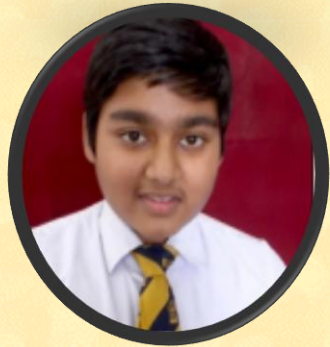

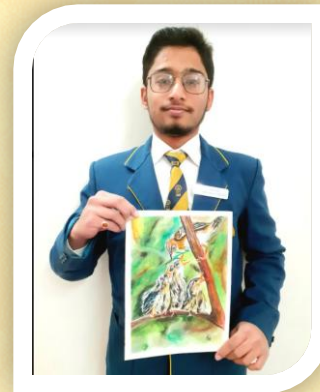

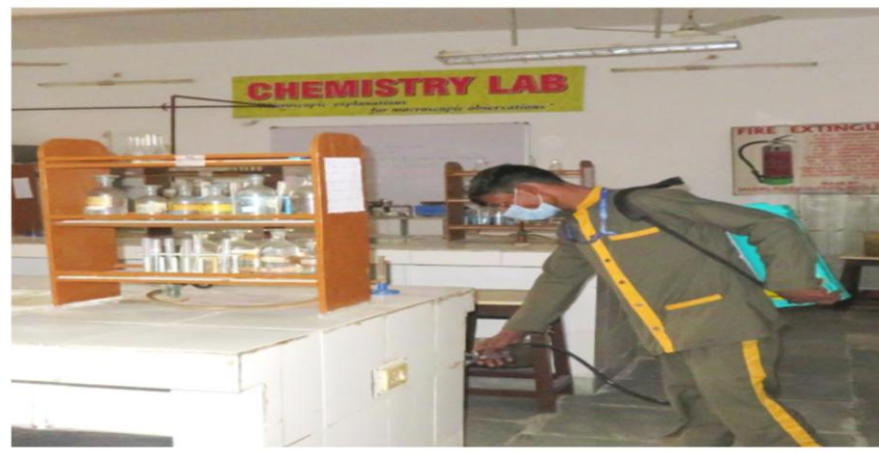

MMPS conducts Activity on Awareness of Water Bodies and Water Sheds of Assam in the line of celebration of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat

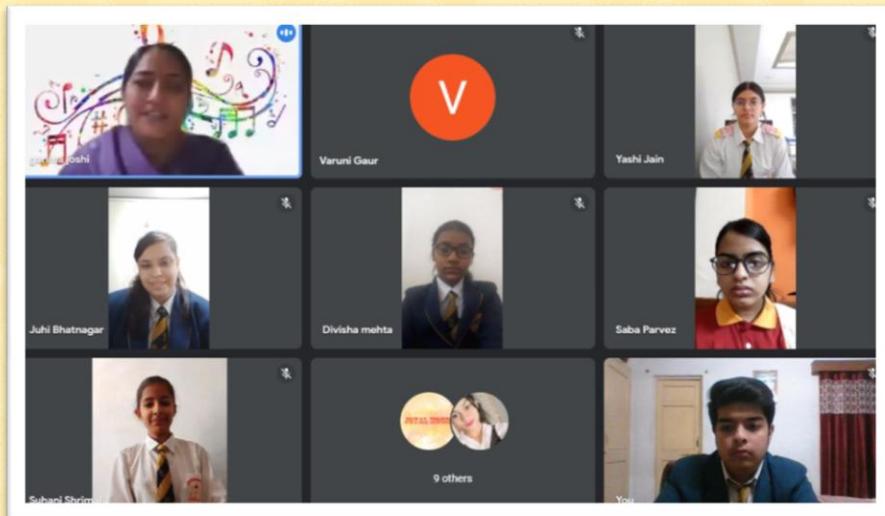

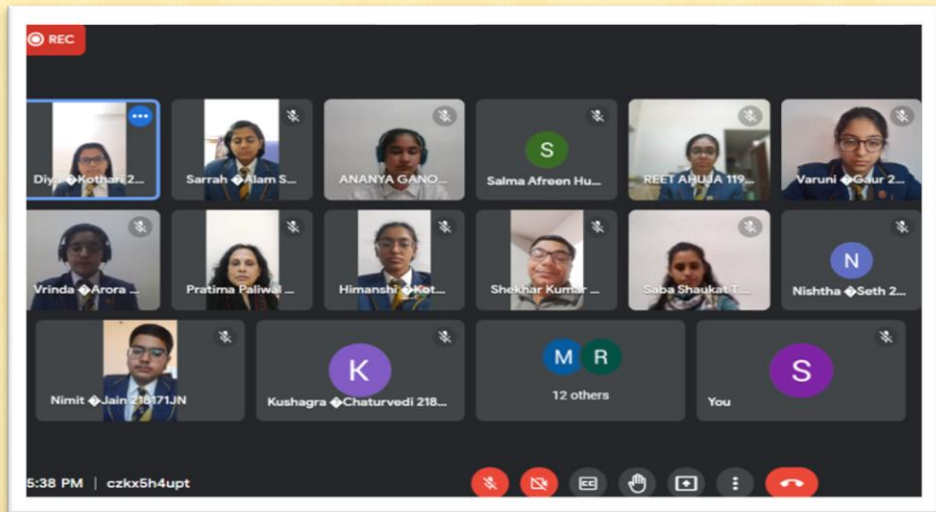
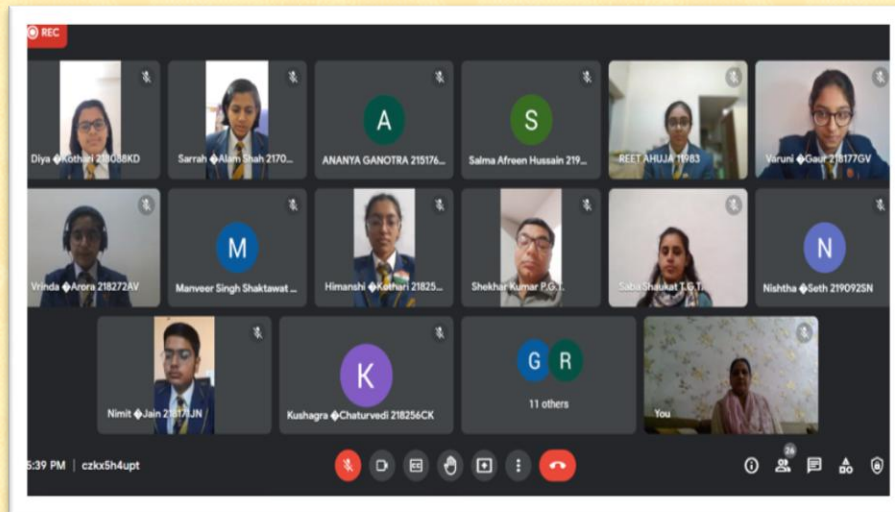
Tribute to the Legendary Kathak Maestro Pandit Birju Maharaj

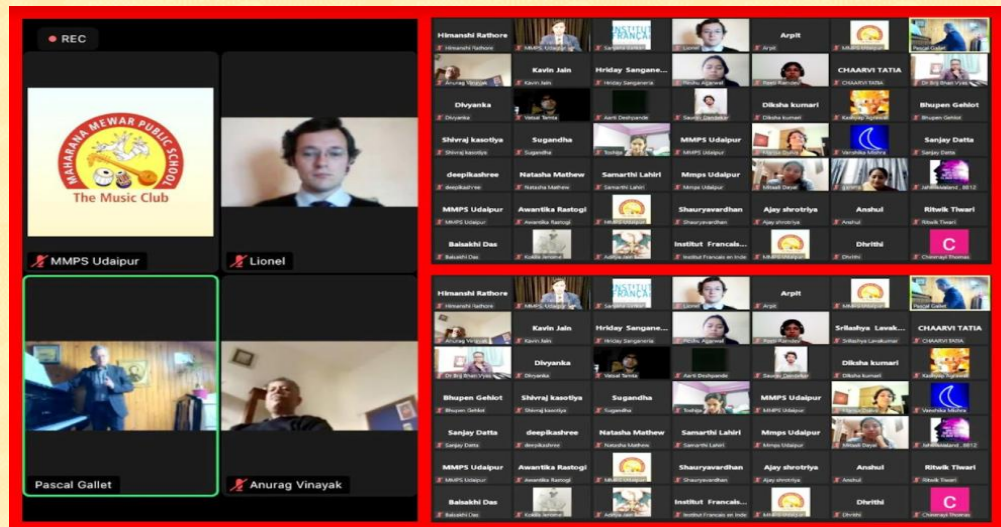
Inoculation Drive at MMPS
