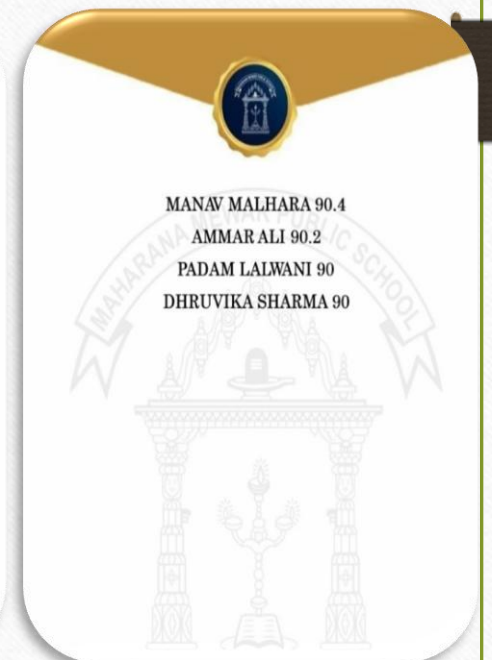
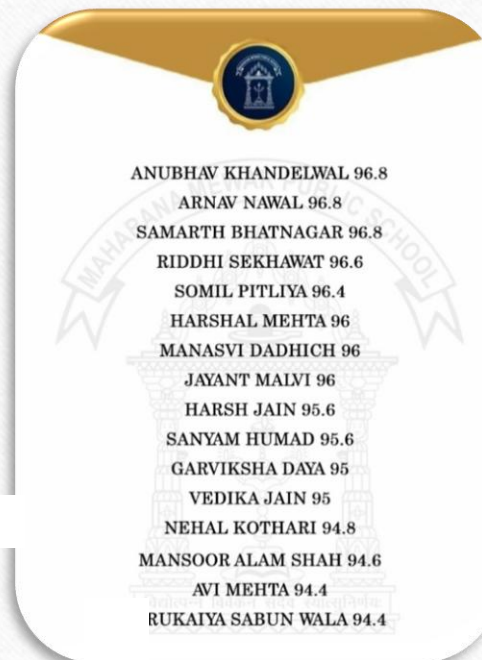

Dwijesh Ameta wins Special Mention Title in Heritage Girls School Model United Nations - 2022 National Edition

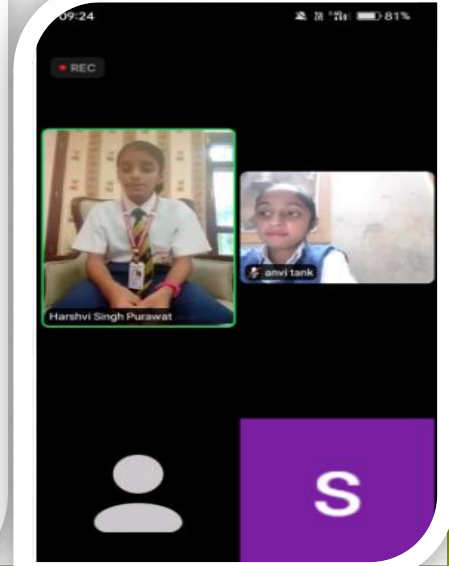
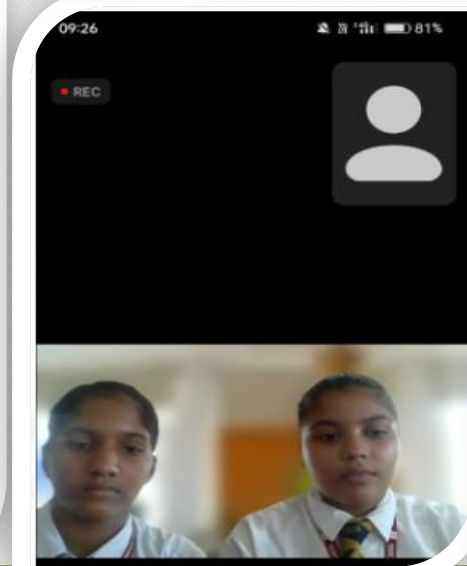

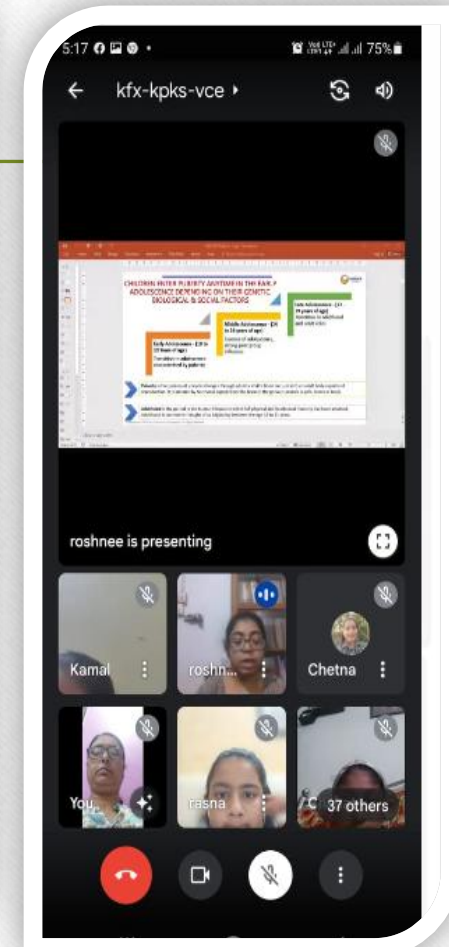
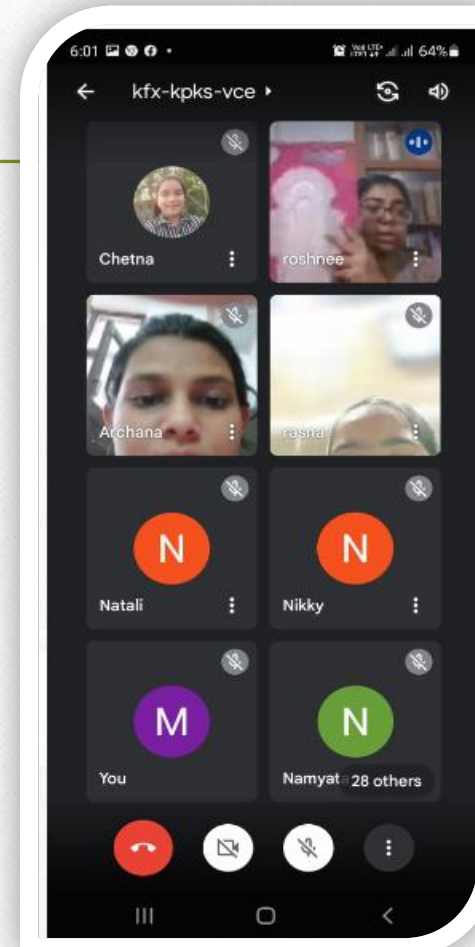
Freshers' Day celebration at MMPS

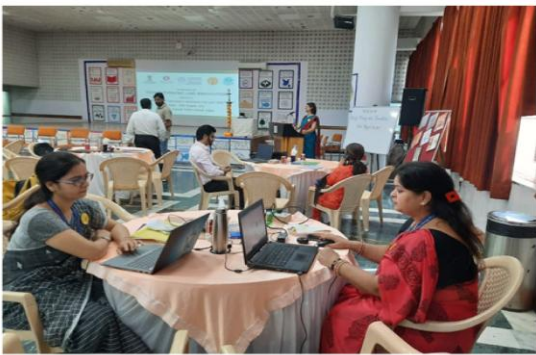
MMPS Staff attends an Interactive Session conducted by Sangath Organisation

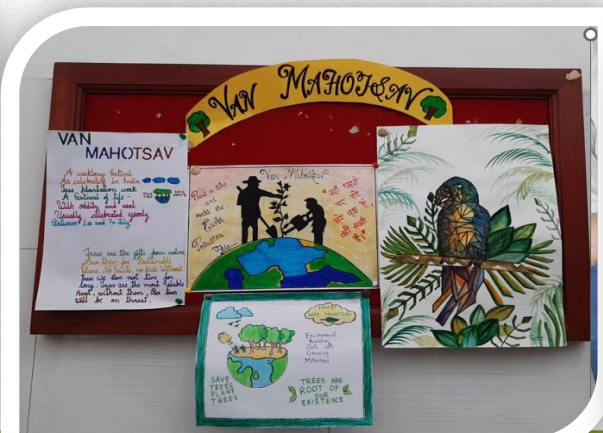




MMPS CLUBS' ACTIVITY

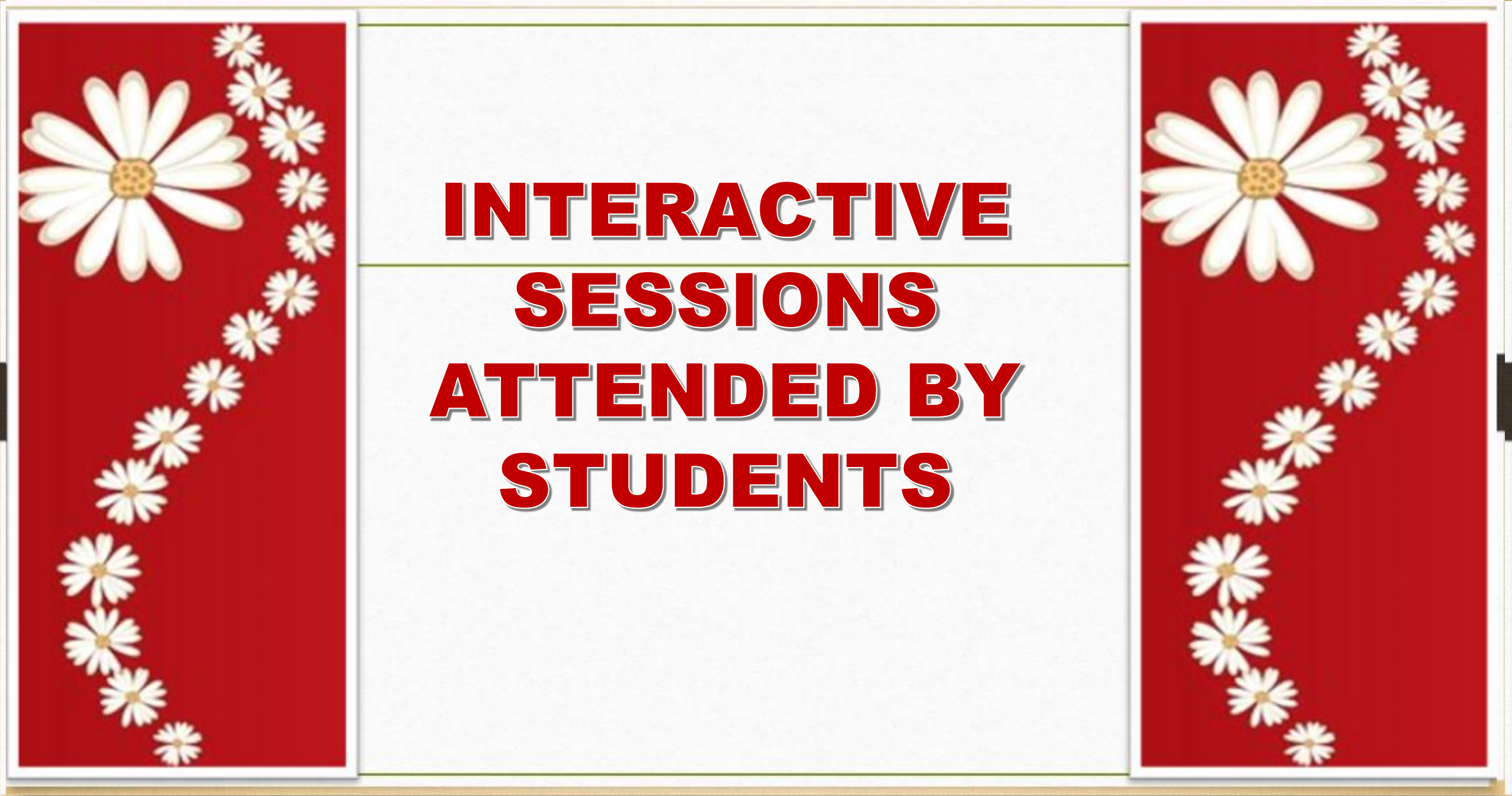
