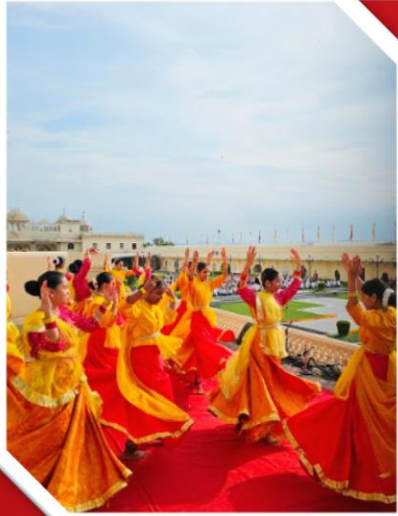

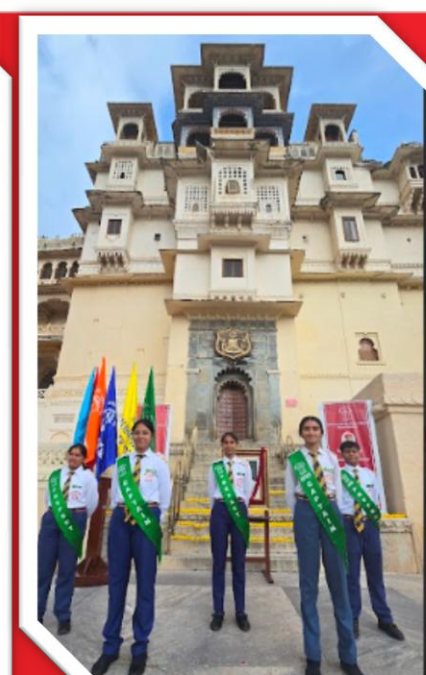

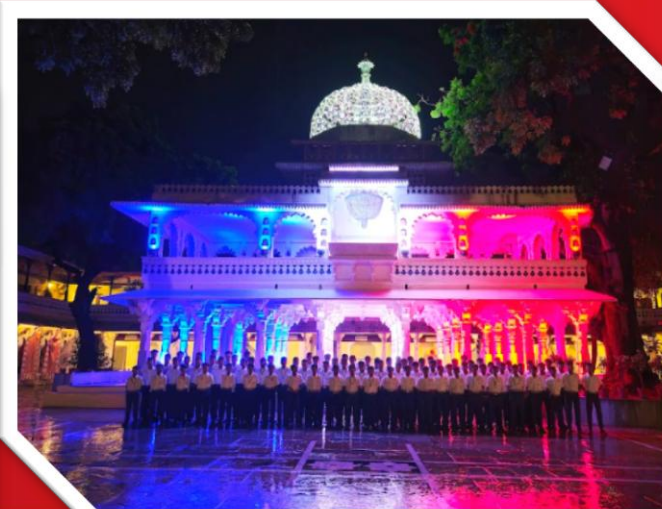






FOSTERING GLOBAL AWARENESS: MMPS CELEBRATES BASTILLE DAY!
