MMPS STUDENTS EXPLORE SPACE SCIENCE AT EFSAT 2025!

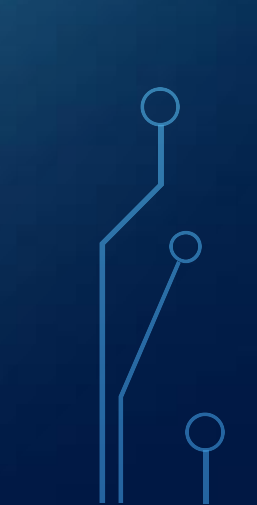

Students designed CubeSAT models using Arduino Nano, sensors, and RF systems, and witnessed a live satellite launch on the final day at GMCH. Accompanied by Mr Anil Paneri, the students gained valuable hands-on experience in aerospace engineering and telemetry.**

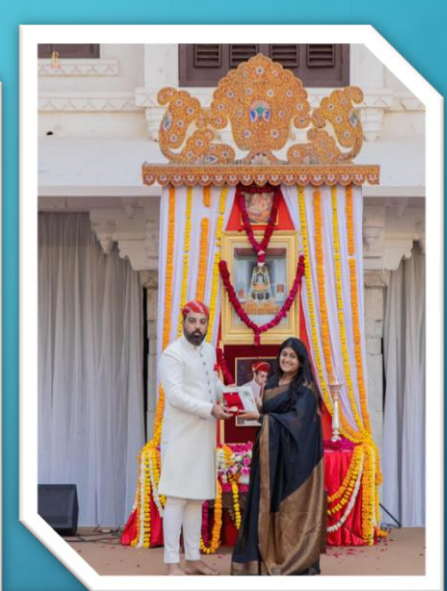

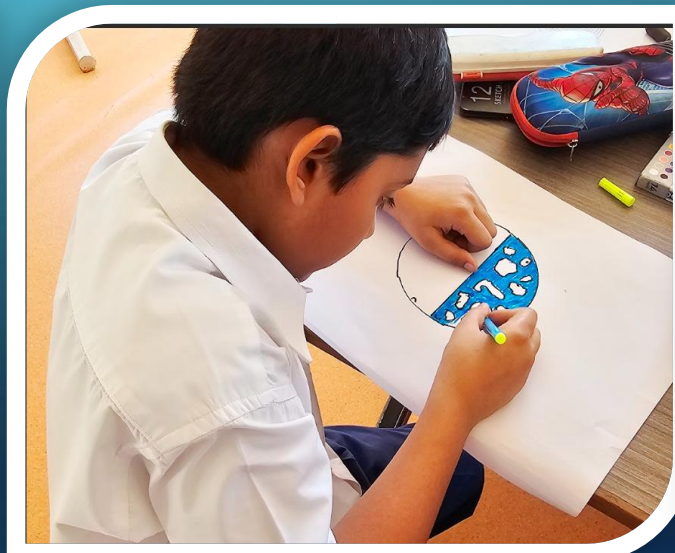
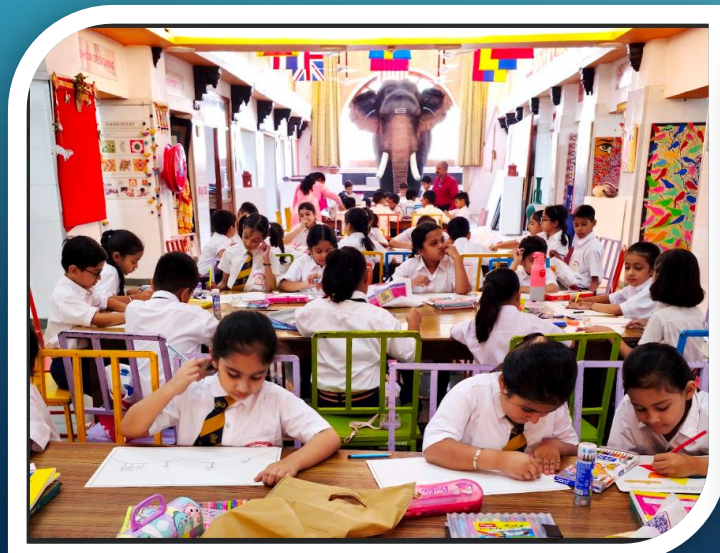
EMPOWER U PROGRAMME CULMINATES WITH GRAND FELICITATION CEREMONY!

ECO CLUB CONDUCTS DIGITAL FLORA SURVEY AT MMPS!

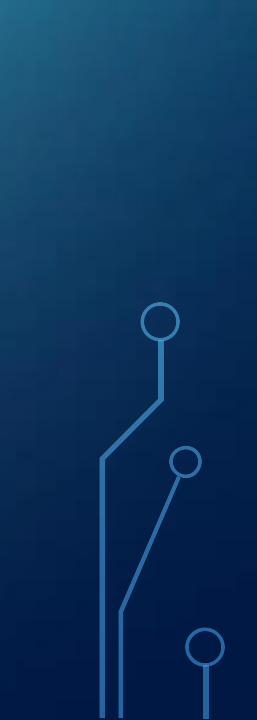
